The campaign seeks to create awareness and provide educational talks around various health related element to the members of community.

The package of services that were rendered on the day includes breast examination and mammogram, cervical cancer screening services, health education on breast examination, other health services, SASSA, Home Affairs services and screening for prostate cancer

Prior to the campaign, there was a briefing at UThukela Municipal Offices where Pink Drive handed a donation to St Chads CHC containing Personal Protective Equipment's (PPE's). St Chads CHC Manager, Dr. SE Mnguni received on behalf of the institution – a significant donation of PPE's to aid health workers in fight against COVID 19.
