U Dr SM Dhlomo ethula inkulumo yakhe yosuku eh-holo lomphakathi Isibanini kuMasipala Umzumbe

Isikhathi sokuma olayini abade emitholampilo, ukukhokha imali eshisiwe yokugibela ukuze iziguli zithole imishanguzo yazo sidlulile. Lokhu kuvele ngenkathi uNgqongqoshe weZempilo KwaZulu Natal uDr SM Dhlomo ethula ngokusemthethweni uhlelo lokulanda amaphilisi ezindaweni eziseduze nasemakhaya noma emsebenzini.

U Dr uDhlomo uthule loluhlelo ngokusemthethweni kwisiFunda sasoGwini ngomhlaka 27 January 2017 kuMasipala waseMzumbe ehholo Isibanini, lapho bekumenywe khona zonke izinhloko zomphakathi, abeZempilo kanye neminye iminyango kahulumeni ukuzothamela lomcimbi.

Loluhlelo luhambisana nomshuwalense weZempilo kaZwelone ozoqala ukusebenza eminyakeni engemingaki ezayo. Zingaphezu kwezinkulungwane ezingama 500 000 iziguli esezingene kuloluhlelo KwaZulu Natal kubalwa nezasoGwini ezingaphezu kwezinkulungwane ezingama 40 000.

Iziguli zisizakala kakhulu kuloluhlelo olunesikhashana luqaliwe kulesisiFunda ngoba sezikuzwa ngendaba ukuma olayini abade, zivuke kusemnyama ziphinde zikhokhe imali ukuze zithole imishanguzo yazo yezifo eziyimbelesela. Abasebenzi boMnyango baxoxela iziguli ngaloluhlelo, bese ziyahlola ukuthi zikulungele yini ukuba zilungenele, zibhaliswe bese zizikhethela zona ukuthi iyiphi indawo ezilungele eseduze nasekhaya noma emsebenzini ezingalanda kuyo imithi. Emva kwezinyanga eziyisithupha kumele loyo olanda imithi abuyele emtholampilo ukuze avuselele aphinde ahlolwe kabusha. Zingaphezu kwama 270 kwisiFunda sasoGwini izindawo esezihlonziwe okulandwa kuzo imithi futhi kusaqhutshekwa nokuhlonza ezinye.

uGogo Ntuli olanda imithi yakhe yezifo eziyimbelesela utshele umphakathi owabe uthamele umcimbi ukuthi impilo yakhe isizakele kakhulu ngoba konke kulula manje uyakwazi nokuthumela ubaba wakwakhe umkhulu uNtuli uma kungavukeki kuye.

Enika inkulumo yokwezeka loluhlelo uSomlomo wasoGwini uCllr N H Gumede uthe bayawubonga uMnyango weZempilo ngokwenza izinto zibe lula ukuze isizwe sisinde. Uthe wonke umuntu ongakwazi akavule ihhovisi lakhe uMnyango ulethe imithi baqhubeka abantu basizakale.

Ethula inkulumo yakhe yosuku uDr SM Dhlomo utshele umphakathi ukuthi awulishumayele lelivangeli lokuthi abantu bayasizakala kuleluhlelo. “Ngifuna niphume la omunye atshele omunye, nomunye aphinde atshele omunye ukuthi sesidlulile isikhathi senhlupheko lapho umuntu engazi ukuthi uzothathani ahlanganise nani ukuze athole ukusizakala.” kuqhuba uNgqongqoshe. Ucele bonke abahlengikazi ukuba basukume ukuze bakhulekelwe uNkulunkulu abahlangenge emisebenzini enzima yokuhlenga izimpilo zabantu abayenzayo. Ephetha inkulumo yakhe uthe abantu baphila impilo ende uma nje beqikelela ukudla imishanguzo yabo ngendlela efanele.

Lomcimbi ubusiswe ngomculo l Gamalakhe CHC ngamaculo aqanjwe akhuluma ngaloluhlelo kanti noNgqongqoshe ukuthokozele kakhulu lokhu.
