The officials advised on possible solutions to gaps identified.













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
THE HAND WASHING CAMPAIGN

They went to Kranskop, Ngcolosi H. School and Vusisizwe P. School








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PUBLIC RELATIONS OFFICE CONDUCTED COMMUNICATIONS OUTREACH SERVICES

The Public Relations officer Mrs. SGW Bonongwe took initiative to visit clinics to reach clinic clients and cascade the information of the hospital being a Covid-19 center, she was giving hope that the primary health care services are still rendered, only patients that need extra care will be referred to neighboring hospitals. She encouraged the pregnant mothers to consider safety and go to other hospitals when they are in Labour, announced that at the entrance of the hospital there is a flu clinic that has been established for every person to check or treat flu symptoms. The chronic patients were encouraged not to default treatment during this time but to ensure compliance in order to maintain the level of their immune system.

This Office together with some Operation Sukumasakhe members visited schools on 11 June 2020 in order to cascade information on how the hospital and Gateway clinic are run during this time of Corona Pandemic. Schools visited were Vusisizwe, Untunjambili P. School, Ngcolosi and Kranskop High School.
