Mthimkhulu (Deputy Nurse Manager) has served for 20 years got the news that the mother of two was Covid-19 positive, A two years old male (Son) with Lower Respiratory Tract Infection (LRTI) and diarrhea and 6 weeks with Broncho pneumonia and diarrhea.

Patients were admitted but were discharged after a week.

The Amandlalathi Clinic had the last cylinder that was

in use but was not yet finished then there was a need to supply the new one in order to prevent Oxygen outage. Mr. K.R. Mthimkhulu took his car since there was an ambulance delay reported. It was after hours which means they were not on duty. It was those afterhours where there was no electricity due to the loadshedding.

They were heroes that had risked their lives since they drove to the Clinic after the Outreach team that was attacked and robbed while they were taking health services to the community through ward based outreach services. to deliberate on this matter.


