**On the 09 October 2012, a delegation from the Department of health: Bruntville CHC and Mooi Mpfana municipality invaded the rural community of Muden, the visit was a follow up visit as households where previously profiled by community care givers through the Operation Sukuma Sakhe Programme.**

n the day the Department of Health KZN donated wheel chairs to the

physically challenged and other assistive devices to the community. The beneficiaries were very over-joyed by the interventions made by the health department, “we shall never forget Bruntville Clinic for giving us wheels” said a delighted beneficiary of the wheel chair.

The rural community of Muden in Umvoti Municipality is to also have a taste of improvements in the delivery of healthcare as promised by the National Health Insurance it will soon have a mini hospital The KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Health Dr Sibongiseni Dhlomo was in the rural Muden to deliver 28 ambulances and announce the construction of a R17, 2 million Community healthcare Centre earlier this year. The construction of the new healthcare centre is also expected to create more than 500 job opportunities’. Mired by deep poverty; the costs of having a sick family member mean loss of hard earned income which is mostly secured from the government social grants.
