The Hospital Manager Ms LN Mate was also delighted about this issue. "It is a critical move from the hospital and I am happy. We are facing a serious Shortage of nurses and hopefully this will address that. The nurses are playing a critical role in driving service delivery and we can't rich our goals without them" The construction company promised that by November 2008 the nurses home could be finished.

The other most important service in the hospital is the Security Division. The person behind the success of this division at Usher Memorial is Mr Skhumbuzo Mjaja, the Principal Security Officer. The 42 year old joined E G Usher Hospital on the 1<sup>st</sup> of February 2008 from KwaCeza Hospital. He has worked as a security guard for more than 20years. "I started at Induna security in 1985, joined Enforce security services in 1989 till 1999. I was very loyal to them though earning peanuts I managed to get married and build my own house" he said softly. Mr Miaia had a brief spell with Fidelity Guards before Joining the Department of Health in February 2001.

The KwaMachi -born started at Murchison Hospital and then got a promotion at KwaCeza Hospital as a Senior Security Officer. "I had to face a huge challenge coming from other place and introduce changes. People will always hate changes" he laughed.

He also said that after joining Usher hospital in February this year (2008) he was surrounded by angry faces and hatred as he came with changes that infuriated some of the staff members. "I want to emphasize that Securities are not the staff opposition, but to protect the institution. Secondly I believe in making a difference and why should I be denied that opportunity?" he asked surprisingly. He touched an important issue that the government should treat securities as an essential service unit. "Without security people's lives are in danger" he said.
