#### OUTREACH

On the **28 February 2018** Emmaus Hospital Mpiloyethu clinic conducted an Outreach programme in the Vimbukhalo area of Emmaus. Joined by Emmaus Gateway clinic who conducted immunizations of children as well as screening. Also joined by NGO **Right to care** who did pap-smears and gave support. The following services were rendered:

- HIV testing with a total of 11 clients tested. Nil clients were positive thus no clients were initiated on ARV treatment.
- Cervical screening with a total of 10 clients screened.
- Tuberculosis screening of all 31 clients with a total of 17 clients formally screened by taking sputum and one child 9 years old referred to Emmaus hospital due to him not being able to produce sputum.
- Hypertension and diabetes screening with total of 31 clients screened.

Minor illness services were also offered to the community by a Clinical Nurse Practitioner with a total of 6 minor illnesses treated and 3 clients referred to hospital.

There was health education given by the site Mentors to the Vimbukhalo community on Condom use both male and female condoms. As well as the importance of HIV testing and cervical screening.

There were also a total of 400 male condoms and 50 female condoms distributed to the community.

Emmaus Hospital conducted this awareness on the 14<sup>th</sup> February 2018 at the High Risk Clinic. The attendance was excellent. The audience consisted of pregnant women in High Risk Clinic, those who attended Gateway Clinic and those that were admitted.

Exercises were done and health education on importance of attending ANC Clinic, danger signs in pregnancy, true signs of labour, family planning, PMTCT, nutrition and importance of taking the prescribed medication.

Questions were asked during the sessions. Gifts were given to all our clients.

Sister Nkabinde thanked all our clients for their participation. Refreshments were given to all our clients.

The day was also aimed at strengthening the programmes that the clinic is offering to prevent diseases/illness and to promote health in the community. The prioritized programmes were Central Chronic Medication Dispensing and Distribution (CCMDD) uptake, Expanded programme Immunization (EPI) under 5 uptake and cervical screening uptake due to poor performance of clinic in the indicators that monitor theses programmes.

Amongst the priozitized programs TB screening, Pap smear etc was also provided on the day

Among the dignitaries present were the ward councilor and the speaker of Okhahlamba municipality Hon. Mr.Zulu, Okhahlamba DOH chaplain Pastor Nkutha and Izinduna(Traditional leaders).
