EMMAUS HOSPITAL ENSURES THAT YOUTH HAVE ACCESS TO OPPORTUNITIES

Emmaus Hospital took an initiative to join the masses of the entire country to commemorate the youth month so that Ukhahlamba youth are not left behind.

With this year's theme focusing mainly on youth empowerment and participation in the countries socio-economic priorities, health, fighting crime and education, Emmaus Hospital felt it necessary that Ukhahlamba youth be empowered like any other youth in the country.

This was witnessed by the recent event held on the 23rd of July 2011 at Emmaus Hospital to empower school learners from various High Schools in the Ukhahlamba Sub-district.

More than 60 High School Learners assembled in the institution where various departments reserved their time to give and expose the learners on various opportunities available in the institution and the Department of Health.

Activities of the day include among others gathering all learners and were informed of the bursaries available in the Department of Health. Our Humana Resources Department gave learners all necessary information

about bursaries available in the department and the all requirements needed to qualify for those bursaries.

The program of the day proceeded by giving the learners various careers available in the Hospital and the department. It should be noted that, most of the learners were in the idea that hospitals only employ nurses and doctors not knowing that there are also other fields that they can pursue their careers.

Among the careers that learners were exposed through the presentations by personnel include, Pharmacy, Radiology, Physiotherapy, Dietics, Nursing and various administration opportunities careers.

The prominent part of the day was when learners were taken to various departments to see the actual work performed in a real situation. Learners were taken to X-Ray department where the X-Ray personnel exposed them to their daily work and had the opportunity to see what equipment is used at X-Ray.

While at the same time they were also exposed at the wards to see what is the daily duty of a nurse. They were also exposed to Pharmacy Department

to see dispensing.

In closing the day Human Resource Manager gave wise words to all learners about the challenges of youth and how to overcome them. She mentioned that today's youth is at the advantages compared to the youth of 76 and back. Today there are many opportunities for youth, there are bursaries, internships and many careers to choose from. She said "it is up to the youth to succeed in life because of the opportunities government and other organizations are giving to the youth of South Africa".

She concluded by saying that youth must wake up and seek for information. The day was closed giving all young girl learners sanitary towels in the form of pads.

It was for this reason that Emmaus Hospital believes that , "An informed and empowered legion of young people who have the skills to make career decisions is likely to improve the skills profile of the overall population and improve mobility between different levels of education and between education and the world of work".
