Report Back: Parliament Imbizo Held Under Hlabisa Sub-District

ommunity of Mtubatuba Municipality under Hlabisa Health Sub-District were more privileged to be paid a visit by Premier of the KwaZulu Natal Province Honourable Mr. E.S Mchunu doing spot check on services delivered to them by different governmental departments.

During this Visit Premier was accompanied by 5 cabinet MEC's, MEC R Pillay for Human Settlement; MEC W Thusi for Social Development; MEC P Nkonyeni for Education;

A project of 18 Classrooms at Qakwini School was officially opened by the Premier, then after her went on to launch Malaria project on ward 8 Qakwini reserve.

Umkhanyakude Health District Manager who is also an Acting Zone 4 Area Manager Ms M.P Themba briefed Premier about the status of Malaria cases within the District and the control measures in place.

The Malaria project is headed by KZN Department of Health and lead by Jozini Malaria Control Program. The project employed about 46 community members to spray mosquitoes in each and every house holds within Qakwini area based on Malaria cases received from this particular area. These employed staff had now finished their training and are now prepared to resume duty ahead of them.

Premier joined Malaria Control Team to their duty and he personally spray household and interacted with the household members stressing the importance of the spraying and appealed for the community members to allow the teams to spray their houses.



Electric switch on for the first time at Ophondweni Reserve ward 7 was also conducted by Premier. This was conducted at Sithole house hold where premier also handed electric appliances to this family headed by a pensioner. During interaction with the family several needs of the family were

identified and referred to relevant Government Departments to intervene urgently.

Members went to attend War Room where Premier and MEC's had time to interact with people and get their feelings about services being delivered to them by the Governmental Departments.

All Members then went to Somkhele

Sport Field where the main Imbizo was held. Normal services were being rendered by respective departments to people attending Imbizo. Hlabisa Hospital was providing Health Screenings. Before end of the event Mr. M Zungu briefed Premier about 5 clients that were profiled through Operation Sukuma Sakhe Project and found eligible for Wheel Chairs, those wheelchairs with blankets were then handed over to these recipients by the Premier. The community was assured of improved health services to be delivered to them through Chronic Medication distribution Centers that will be implemented within their com-

munity to reduce workload and long waiting time at the clinics and Hospital. Philamntwana Centers that will be focusing to the well baby services are also on the pipeline for implementation within the area.



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
