CONDOM AND PREGNANCY AWARENESS

Hlabisa hospital championed by Maternity section and events committee took an initiative in educating and sensitizing community about pregnancy, condoms and STI during the pregnancy awareness week. Awarenesses were done in clinics, schools and pension day places targeting women and teenagers. Due to the increasing number of teenage pregnancy and teenagers being infected by HIV/ Aids, awareness was done to schools. Hlabisa Hospital surrounding high schools were visited and it is the place where teenagers are found. They were told about results of early sex engagement by teenagers including STI's, pregnancy and HIV.

Awareness were also done in pension places during pension day where women and parents were found gathered. They were targeted because they are the ones who stay with teenagers and they are mother in-laws. They were also advised to encourage their pregnant daughters to start clinic early so that tests can be done early and if there is a need mother can start treatment early to serve the life of a child.

School children were advised to abstain from sex or those who have already started and could not abstain were advised to use condoms. They were also advised and encouraged to visit clinics as early as two months after missing periods and if someone suspects or see changes on her private parts.

The clinic had no call system, it was only working during weekdays and the community were suffering if there are any emergencies as there was no accommodation for nurses. The big day to the community of Inhlwathi and surroundings was on the 18th of March 2011, the event was held at Edengeni Sports ground (Inhlwathi). The opening of the clinic were combined with the sod turning of the road to Hluhluwe by the Department of Transport and the launch of the school at Inhlwathi by the Department of Education.
