The programme was too heavy for one program Director and that resulted to it being directed by two Gentlemen's Mr. N Madondo co-hosting with Mr Z Dlamini.

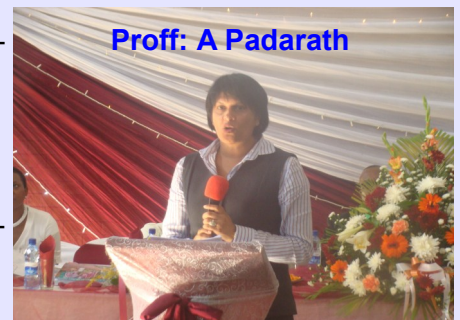
