Mrs Agnes Nzama gave a cataract surgery testimony. She removed cataract at Stanger Hospital and she gained her sight back. She encouraged others to go for cataract removal because it is pain free and quick to do.

Cllr Nzuza, Cllr Sithole (Maphumulo Municipality) and Mr Gcwabaza (Hospital Board Member) all gave messages of support and encouraged citizens to go to health facilities to check their health status because prevention is

better than cure. Health services were provided and people came in numbers to access health services. Clients were also screened for disabilities and 10 received new walking sticks. Refreshments were provided for community members as well as officials and VIPs.
