ILembe Health District conducted its HAST Service Excellence Awards on 15 June 2023 at Amatikulu Training Centre. The District Director: Ms T.E Maphalala gave the purpose of the day and she mentioned that it was to acknowledge and celebrate outstanding achievements by health facilities in the quest to end the HIV/AIDS pandemic as a public health threat by 2030. She also introduced the new Chief Executive Officer for Montebello District Hospital: Mrs Z. Mzobe.

Mr Menzi Kunene gave a district performance overview focusing on HIV prevention, Ms Mbali Zungu (former TB coordinator) shared TB control programme (TBCP) performance and alluded to the fact that all drugs TB clients started on treatment (finding missing cases) is outstanding. Mr V. Bhengu presented HIV Testing Services (HTS), care and treatment. He mentioned that district annual performance under care and treatment was also good. All presenters shared strategies to improve district performance on other indicators hence the best performing facilities were awarded.

Rev. S. Shangase from the Provincial Department of Health: Employee Health and Wellness Programme Unit encouraged employees to take care of themselves because their life is important and very personal. "Have time for yourself and with yourself". "Be personal about your life everyday not only on your birthdays". "Consider your feelings and refuse conditions that make you feel uncomfortable in life". "It is only when you feel good that you will take care of anyone next to you". He further encouraged staff to work on your feelings until they are comfortable. In closing, Rev. Shangase encouraged staff to personalise their faith because it is a source of strength.
