

The theme for the week pharmacy week was to use antibiotics wisely.


Health education on the utilization of antibiotics and all other medication was given to patients. They were also made aware on the correct way to handle, store and dispose of medication

OPEN DAY- CAREERS EXPO 2014







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

They were provided with "Careers in Health Handbook" as well as Clinical Associate Booklet. Students were sensatized of the bursaries that Department of Health KZN offer.





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
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WELLNESS WEEK
