WHEELCHAIR REPAIR UNIT VISITED BY THE PROVINCIAL DISABILITY OFFICE, DISTRICT AND PROVINCIAL REHABILITATION COORDINATORS AND PARTNERS (CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST)

KZN has 8 wheelchair repair sites and Zululand has 3 sites. Itshelejuba hospital is one of the wheelchair repair sites.

It started in 2004, there are two wheelchair repairers. They work in the Rehabilitation unit, sharing the space with the therapist since it was best for our clients to have easy access to the service.

Itshelejuba wheelchair repair site was visited just to showcase it to the partners who are working with the department of health.

The partners donated 5 various types of wheelchairs, spares to the value of R15 000 and other assistive devices such as comodies, white canes and they will be meeting MOP's so that they can also help with MOP's appliances.

They will train wheelchair repairers and the priority is 8 people from rural areas and 2 disabled people. They will also train therapist through 5 days course and 3 days refresher course. These courses are accredited.


