INTERNATIONAL NURSE'S DAY OF PRAYER—12 MAY 2021



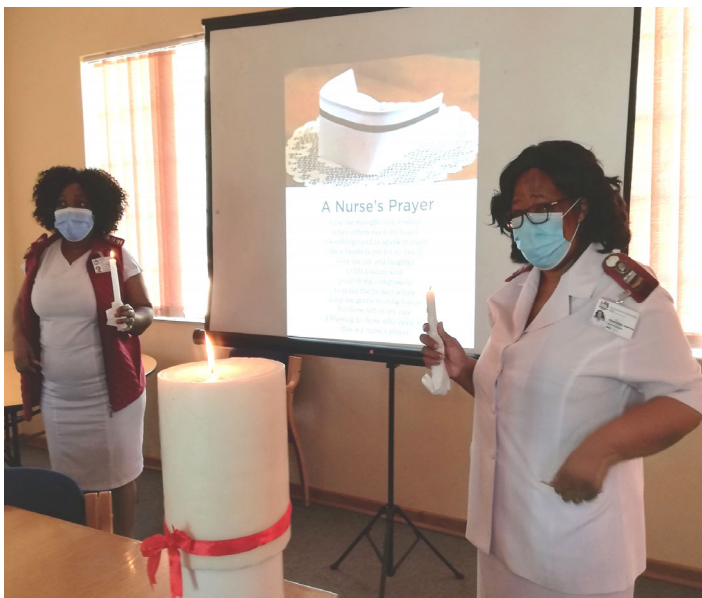

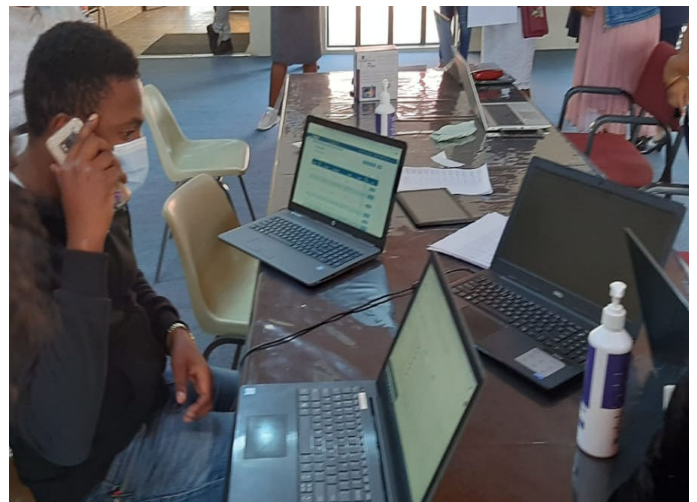

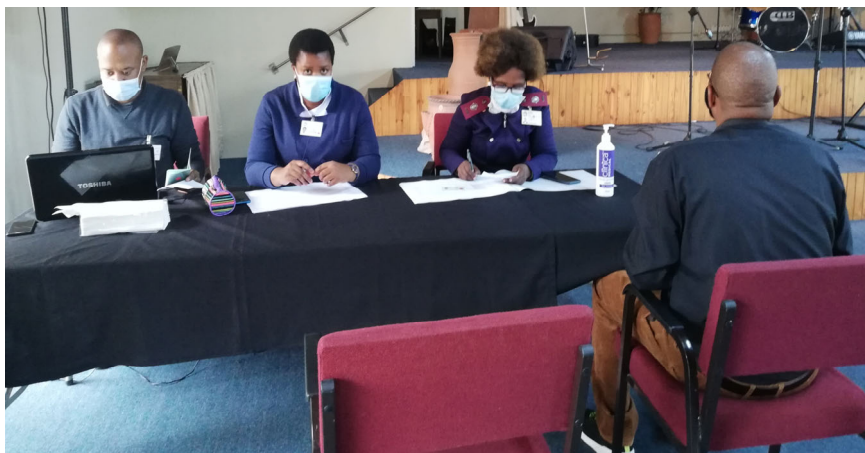

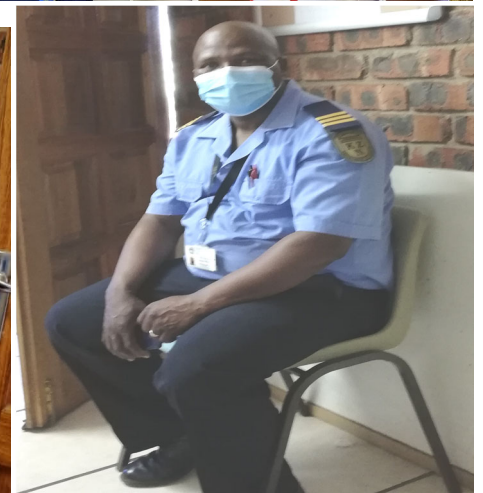
