The CEO and Management called staff meeting urgently to make the staff aware about the renovations that are about to happen within the hospital.



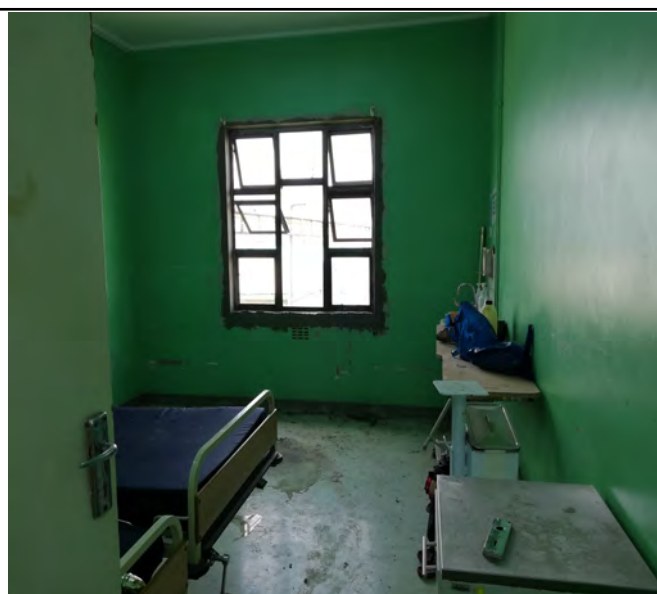

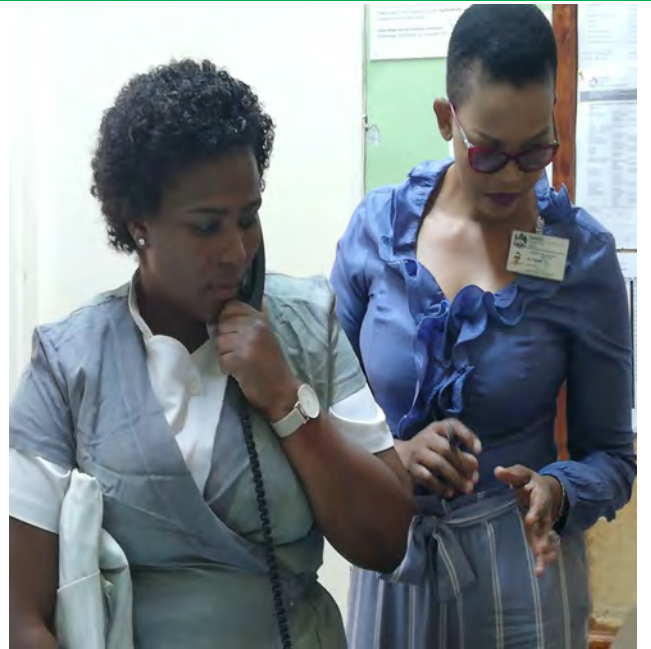

It is a droplet infection, and it stays up to 9 days. It presents with a flu and lead to organ failure. There is currently no vaccine to treat the disease.

Tips to minimize transmission of the disease were highlighted which included adherence to hand wash practices, hence the drill on use of hand rub was conducted.

Coronaviruses are a large family of viruses that cause not only the common cold but also more serious respiratory illnesses

Symptoms

- Runny nose
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Fever
- Cough



How it spreads

- The air by coughing and sneezing
- Close personal contact, such as touching or shaking hands
- Touching an object or surface with the virus on it, then touching your mouth



Prevention

- Wash your hands often with soap and water
- Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands
- Avoid close contact with anyone showing symptoms of respiratory illness
- Thoroughly cook meat and eggs

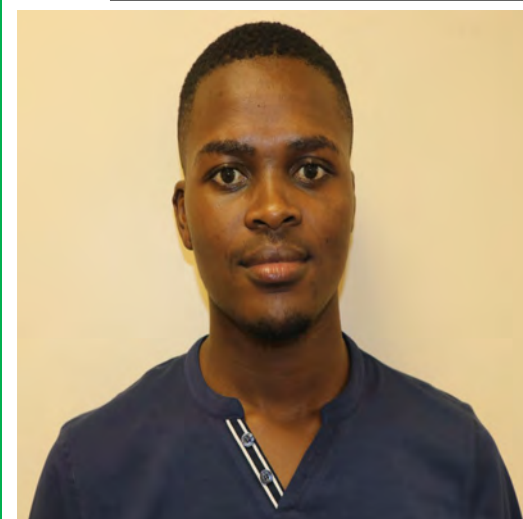
