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FIRST AID TRAINING WITH DO MORE FOUNDATION



Mrs. HG Theron (QAM) visited Belgrade community at Thusong Centre for first aid training with DO MORE Foundation. Training was attended by 0-5 years crèche principals and practitioners. The training was based to ABCD(A– Airway, B-Breathing, & C-Circulation & D-Do not delay start immediately). Mrs. Theron taught about the amount of blood human has in the body, she also taught about how to stop bleeding in a child and to adults, how to give a First Aid to a person with a broken arm or leg. She also taught about how to help a person who drowned in the water if he/she is still breathing (AR) and not breathing anymore (CPR). Attendees really enjoyed the training and showed that they understood what they are taught because after being taught they applied what they are taught by acting with dolls and to each other.

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BREASTFEEDING WEEK



Breastfeeding is an amazing way to protect new-born babies and infants; quite simply, it saves lives. Breast milk is a superfood for babies and a powerful, natural antidote to hunger and disease. Breastfeeding ensures babies get all the energy, nutrients and water they need to develop and it also keeps the infant safe from life-threatening dangers such as unclean water or bacteria in food. To minimise the risks of infections and other illnesses, infants should begin breastfeeding within the first hour of life and continue to breastfeed exclusively – that is, without any other foods or liquids – for six months, and then with complementary food for up to two years and beyond.

School Health team under Ncotshane Clinic presented Department of Health at Masithokoze Primary School talking about the services rendered by School Health in schools. They were talking about the importance of making schools to be health promoting schools. Screening and assessments of children for early detection of health problems and refer them to the relevant facilities, for eye care, dental care, ear problems, psychosocial problems, assessing for signs of all kinds of abuse and giving health talks on the effects of teenage pregnancy and substance abuse. They were also giving immunization e.g. human papilloma on virus (HPV) on grade five girls 9 years and above in public and special schools, tetanus and diphtheria (TD) to children at 6 years both boys and girls and also at 12 years. The community members, teachers and all stakeholders were there to attend the School Health.
