ADMISSIONS

All admissions are done in our admitting department between 7:30 to 16:00 on weekdays only. Patients are advised to bring:

1. Identity document
2. Referral letter
3. Medical Aid card
4. Employment particulars/pay slips if necessary
5. Name, Address and phone number of contact person

OTHER IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- ? Patients under 18 years must be accompanied by parent or guardian.

- ? Please comply with all instructions and requirements given by our admission officers.
- ? Hospital patients are requested to pay their accounts on admission or as soon as possible.

FEES

All our patients (cash or medical aid) are charged as per the Uniform Patients Fee Schedule (UPFS), prescribed by the Department of Health and are subject to change. Unfortunately we have no facilities for credit card payment.

VALUABLES

Patients are allowed to use their own sleeping attire but the Hospital attire is available. Clothes will be kitted in the kit room for safe keeping, but money is held at our revenue offices and a receipt will be issued. Firearms must be handed over to security prior to entering the hospital premises.

TELEPHONE CALLS

Telephones are for the use by hospital personnel only and they are also responsible for conveying all telephone messages received on behalf of patients, but private calls may be made for specific purposes.

Telephone booths are available all around the hospital and cellular phones may be brought into the hospital at patients own risk. Patients must be aware of areas where the use of cell phone is prohibited, eg theatre.
