

- A Waiting Time Survey was undertaken during March 2005 in the following manner:
- A total of 200 patients were surveyed.
- 50 patients from the Main Pharmacy,
- 50 from Psychiatry Pharmacy,
- 25 from the MDR follow up clinic,
- 25 from the Spinal OPD Clinic,
- 25 from the Thoracic OPD Clinic,
- 25 from the Psychiatry OPD Clinic.



As illustrated in the graph, the findings were as such :

- 60% of patients waited between 0-30 minutes,
- 16.5% of patients waited between 1 to 2 hours,
- 16% of patients waited between 2 to 3 hours,
- 4% waited between 3 5 hours,
- 3.5% waited 5 hours and more.

- N.B. 100% of patients waited 0-30 minutes in Psychiatry Pharmacy and Main Pharmacy
- 20% of OPD patients waited 0-30 minutes
- 16.5% of OPD patients waited 1 to 2 hours
- 16% of OPD patients waited 2-3 hours
- 4% of OPD patients waited 3-5 hours
- 3.5% of OPD patients waited 5 hours and longer
