2008/09 1/1000



Abudja 2000: Half malaria deaths by 2010




DISEASE BURDEN




Malar Abudja 2000: Half malaria deaths by 2010

- Vector control
 - Personal protection & ITNs
 - Larviciding
 - Entomological investigations



- Diagnosis, Case management & Drug monitoring
- Epidemic preparedness and response
- Surveillance, Information & Research
- IEC, Advocacy & Community mobilization



CONTRIBUTORY FACTORS TO THE DEATHS

- Inquest into malaria deaths
 - Late reporting to health posts
 - HIV/Aids pandemic
 - High staff turnover
 - Lack of experience amongst newly recruited health cadres.
 - Poorly equipped ICU services within the health institutions

- SADC MALARIADAY 2005
- IEC IMPLEME NTATION PLAN
- TRAINING OF TRADIONALPRACTITIONERS





CHALLENGES

- Poor IRHS coverage while malaria incidence is low
- Poor turnover of staff where malaria issues are discussed (training).
- Unpackaged devolution of malaria activities
- Communication & command-lines in DHS
- High staff turnover & dispondency
- The future of diagnosis & under-qualified



PRIORITIES

- Collaboration
- Embracing of decentralization and making it work for the Malaria Control Unit
- Understanding insecticide resistance patterns for informed decision making
- Occupational Health & Safety of employees in the workplace including HIV/Aids education
