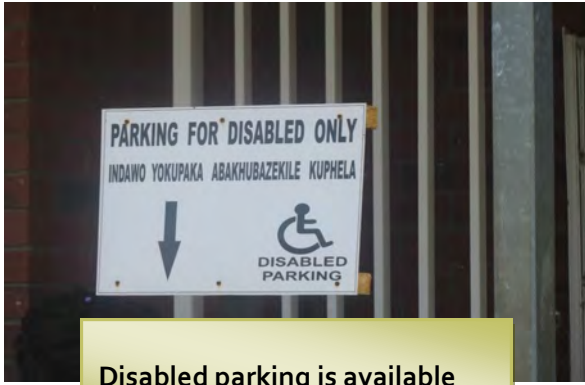

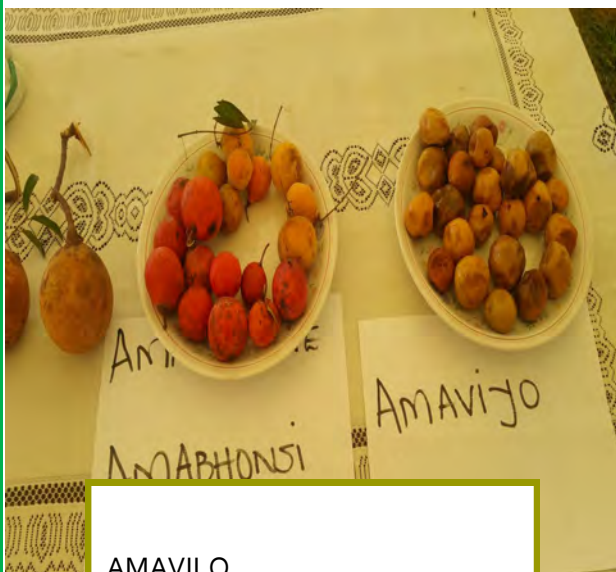

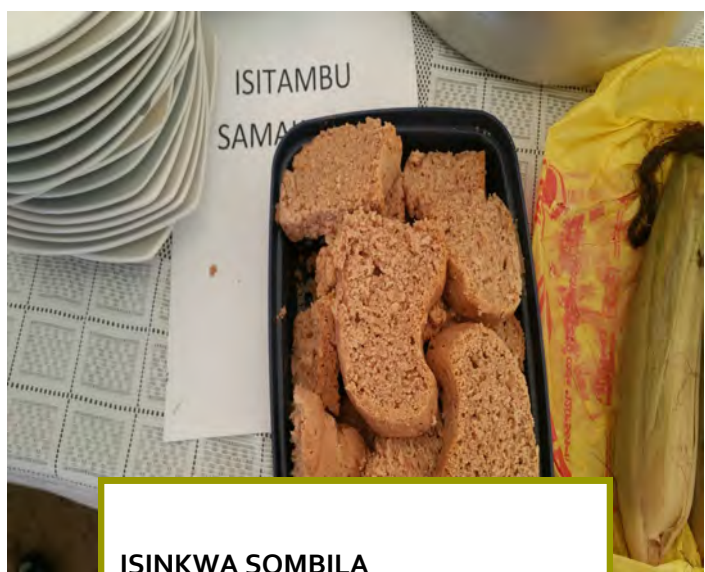

# TRADITIONAL FOOD TASTING

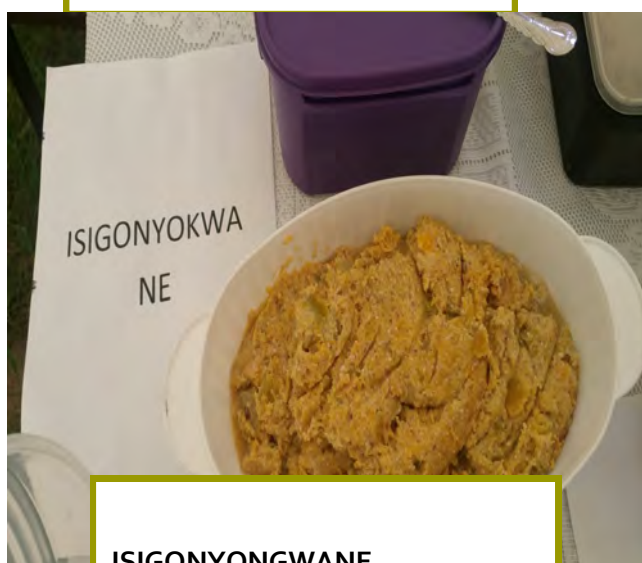

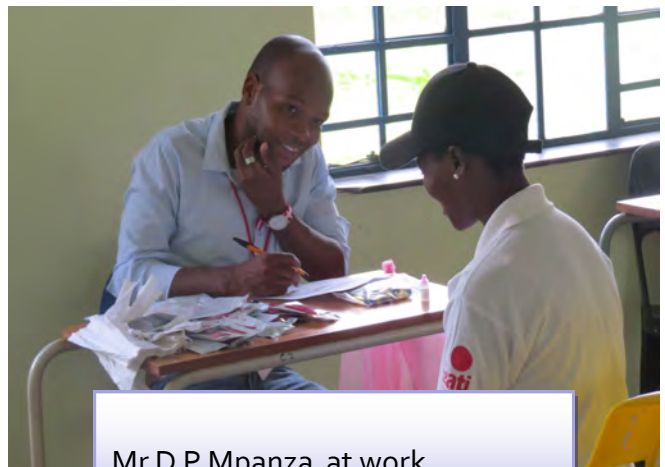
