CHOLERA AWARENESS CAMPAIGN



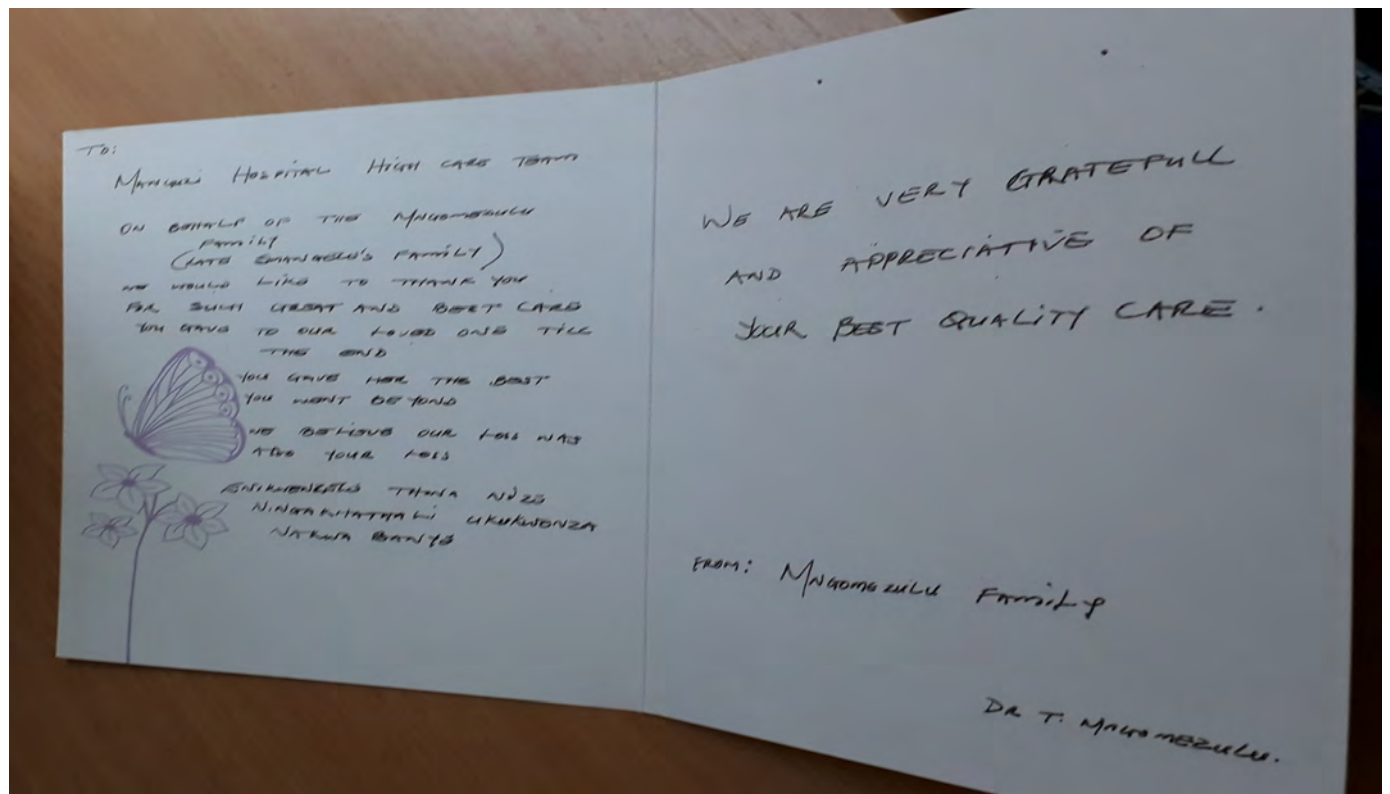
