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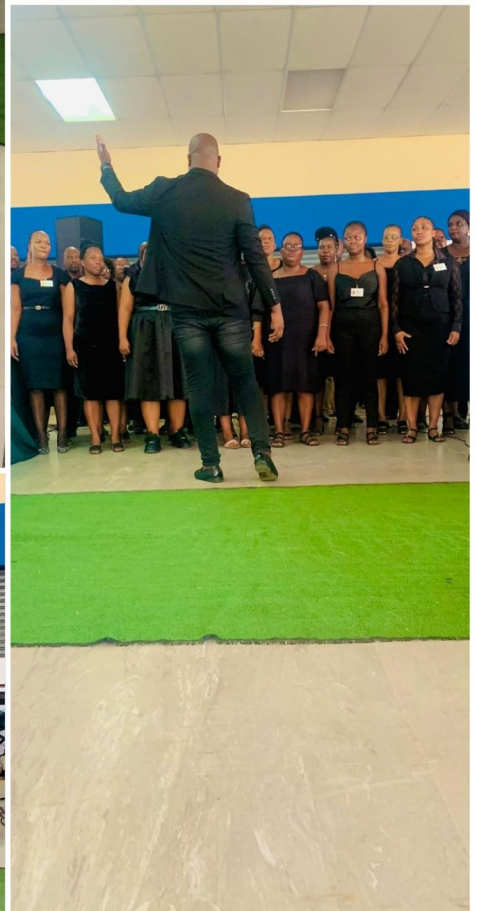

**In ensuring that the services reach out to people, Manguzi hospital continues to reach out to communities by strengthening community services.**

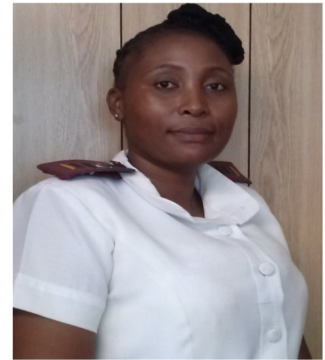
