

Media Statement on the refurbishment of a nursery at RK Khan hospital

30 June 2014

The KZN Department of Health is to embark on a process to refurbish a nursery at the RK Khan Hospital.

This is part of the Department's on-going infrastructure renewal. All babies that are currently admitted at this institution will be repatriated to McCord Hospital to ensure that service delivery is not compromised while the work continues.

All mothers that are due for delivery and are transported by ambulance will be transported to other hospitals within Durban for delivery, pending the completion of the refurbishment of the nursery at RK Khan Hospital.

Walk-in mothers will still deliver their babies at RK Khan Hospital and if babies require admission they will be transferred to McCord Hospital and other surrounding hospitals within Durban.
