then to Bethesda Hospital and on Tuesday, the  $17^{\text{th/11/09}}\,\text{he}$  covered Manguzi & Mseleni Hospital.

His areas of concern at uMkhanyakude Health District were: TB cure rate, Prevention of Mother to Child Transmission, HIV and AIDS where he praised the District Management for initiating the Ante retroviral treatment to all the clinics, Immunization, Antenatal Visits and Mortality Rates.

He was greatly impressed by the low Infant mortality rate that he learnt was a norm in all the visited Hospitals. He likened the indication showed that Mosvold was similar to Dundee Hospital, where not even one infant died for the 2008/2009 period.

MEC, Dr. S.M. Dhlomo commented that, in the olden days the whole community would prepare feasts waiting for a woman to come back with her baby full of joy, but now that is no longer guaranteed as in most cases the mother or the baby or both will not come back.

MEC, Dr. S. Dhlomo says most deaths occur because pregnant women do not attend antenatal classes especially within 20 weeks in their preg-S. Dhlomo nancy. He said, it is worse has covered with the teenagers who hide to their pregnancy and surface km only when it is time to deliver. He further said that makes it of very difficult for the doctors & to nurses to save the baby or the mother's lives should any abnormality or illness be discovtrict, visiting ered at that stage when the four Hospibaby is due. within days. Appreciating, the cooperation showed by the Hospital Board members as well as Community councilors, MEC, Dr. S. Dhlomo challenged them to support the health care system in the mobilizing of the community about the necessity of pregnant women to frequently visit the hospital/clinic classes. He also appealed to them to play a meaningful role in the health care needs of the people in their communities for instance, by forcing people who have been coughing for more than 2 weeks to go for TB test.

For all the good practices that he witnessed in all the 4 hospitals visited, he urged the hospital CEO's to send him reports that he intends to share with other hospitals who are not doing well in the Province.


"Below are the results of the 3rd quarter year 09/10. Therefore as we approach the festive season of the year, I wish you all the best and a happy new year. Lets
