NGWELEZANA'S ANAESTHETICS DEPARTMENT SCOOPS AN AWARD AT THE NATIONAL CPSI COMPETITION

At a recent awards ceremony held by the Centre for Public Service Innovation under the South African Public Service and Administration Department, Ngwelezana Hospital's The awards were about unearthing the wealth of innovation that exists in Public Service but is often unrecognised.

Out of 160 initial entries in the whole of South Africa, all in the Public Service; there were different four categories namely; Innovative Partnerships in Service Delivery, Innovative use of ICTs for Effective Service Delivery, Innovative Enhancements of Internal Systems of Government and Innovative Service Delivery Institutions in the whole of South Africa.

Ngwelezana hospital's Anaesthetics department grabbed a 2nd place trophy for coming up with an innovative idea in the Innovative Service Delivery Institutions category.

Their Project name was called Safe Anaesthesia for Africa Project, which addresses the South African challenges of deaths that are related to anaesthesia, meaning a person dying as a result of an operation or being operated on. The deaths are mainly due to Airway and circulation complications.

Ngwelezana Hospital implemented a system designed to aid performance and improves the skills of medical officers in anaesthesia, especially in the airway and circulation manage-

ment which was traditionally practised by specialist anaesthetics in South Africa.

The project was later rolled out throughout the region with the support and blessing of Department of Health. The ultimate aim is to roll the project throughout South Africa; it can also help reduce death that is related to child-birth, one of the top priorities of the South African Government.


