Condom and pamphlets were distributed to taxi drivers, salons and shopping centres. Richmond municipality traffic department played crucial role in this march as they were ushering the cars. Over 17 000 male and 1300 female condom were distributed on the day.

Though the day was planned for AIDS day awareness, the issue of COVID 19 was not left aside during the march. The importance of wearing mask, washing hand and social distance was also emphasised. "Please leave your house only if there is an important reason because the COVID 19 is still here" this was some of the messages that was conveyed on the day.
