2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.

6. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

1 PURPOSE, SCOPE AND DEFINITIONS OF CONTRACT WORK CATEGORIES
The purpose of this contract specification is to procure the services of a reputable, competent
and accredited contractor to execute maintenance and repair works on the Mechanical
