### **SPECIFICATION**

TWELVE MONTHS CONTRACT FOR THE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL OF GENERAL WASTE AND TO SUPPLY 3x 7 METER CUBED WASTE SKIP FROM MONDAY TO SATURDAY AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS FOR GREY'S HOSPITAL

#### 1. SCOPE OF WORK

The work to be carried out under this contract includes a three year period contract for the collection and removal of general waste and to supply a waste skip from Monday to Friday (including public holidays). Service provider must leave the area in a suitable condition to the satisfaction of the secretary for the department. The area should be left neat and tidy.

General waste is the non-hazardous waste from health facilities that includes same waste as domestic waste. It is generated during the administrative and housekeeping functions of public health care establishments as well as from patients and visitors, and it includes the following types of waste:

- Office waste: includes packing materials, cardboard boxes and plastic bags
- · Kitchen waste: packing material.
- Building and demolishing waste: from institutional onsite construction and renovation activities and all uncompactable waste.

# 1.1. The work comprises of

- 1.1.1 3 X 7m³ skips with lid / tarpaulin to be supplied and placed in the designated waste skip area.
- 1.1.2 Waste should be collected daily including public holidays or as agreed with the institution/health facility.
- 1.1.3 Driver of the waste removal truck must report to Maintenance Department/ waste Management officer to sign the Waste Management Book (the waste collection document must consist of three copies, one copy to be left in the institution, one copy to be taken by the driver.
- 1.1.4. A third copy to be serving as disposal certificate produced together with the monthly invoices.
- 1.1.5. Skip bins to be washed by service provider every three months.
- 1.1.6 The service provider must keep records of all work done in terms of time, cost, quantity and these must be submitted on monthly basis with the invoice to the relevant health facilities.

be used, the aperture size must be smaller than the waste particle size to prevent the waste escaping through the net, and shall be no greater than 150mm x 150mm. The net or cover must be properly fastened to the vehicle or waste container.

- 2.10 Precautions shall be taken to prevent spillage or leakage during transportation from all vehicles used to collect and/or transport municipal solid wastes that produce leachate.
- 2.11 Any waste spillage that occurs during the collection and transport of waste must be cleaned up immediately. No transportation may continue should waste be observed to be falling out of the transportation vehicle, but driver must stop and secure waste to prevent waste spillage.
- 2.12 Vehicles used for collection and transportation of waste shall be cleaned frequently to prevent nuisances arising such as odour or insect breeding.
- 2.13 All waste collectors and transporters must be registered with their local authority.

#### SPECIAL CONTRACT CONDITIONS OF QUOTATIONS

#### 1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

1.1. Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

#### 2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

### 3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
  - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- 3.4. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.
- 3.5. This quotation will be evaluated based on the 80/20 points system, specification & correctness of information. All required documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
- 3.6. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.
- 3.7. Only offers that meet or are greater than the specification will be considered.
- 3.8. Late quotes will not be considered.
- 3.9. Expired product/s will not be accepted. All products supplied must be valid for a minimum period of six months.
- 3.10. A bidder not registered on the Central Suppliers Database or verification has failed will not be considered.
- 3.11. All delivery costs must be included in the quote price, for delivery at the prescribed destination.
- 3.12. Only firm prices will be accepted. Such prices must remain firm for the contract period. Non-firm prices (including rates of exchange variations) will not be considered.
- 3.13. In cases where different delivery points influence the pricing, a separate pricing schedule must be submitted for each delivery point.
- 3.14. In the event of a bidder having multiple quotes, only the cheapest according to specification will be considered. Furthermore a verification will be done to identify if bidders have multiple companies and are quoting (cover-quoting) for this bid. In such instances only the cheapest bid according to specification will be considered.

# 4. SAMPLES

- 4.1. In the case of the quote document stipulating that samples are required, the supplier will be informed in due course when samples should be provided to the institution. (This decreases the time of safety and storage risk that may be incurred by the respective institution). The bidders sample will be retained if such bidder wins the contract.
- (i) If a company/s who has not won the quote requires their samples, they must advise the institution in writing of such.
- (ii) If samples are not collected within three months of close of quote the institution reserves the right to dispose of them at their discretion.
- 4.2. Samples must be made available when requested in writing or if stipulated on the document,
- (i) If a Bidder fails to provide a sample of their product on offer for scrutiny against the set specification when requested, their offer will be rejected. All testing will be for the account of the bidder.

### 6. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

6.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

#### 7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

7.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

#### 8. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 8.1. In the event that the tax compliance status has failed on CSD, it is the suppliers' responsibility to provide a SARS pin in order for the institution to validate the tax compliance status of the supplier.
- 8.2. In the event that the institution cannot validate the suppliers' tax clearance on SARS as well as the Central Suppliers Database, the quote will not be considered and passed over as non-compliant according to National Treasury Instruction Note 4 (a) 2016/17.

#### 9. TAX INVOICE

- 9.1. A tax invoice shall be in the currency of the Republic of South Africa and shall contain the following particulars:
- (i) the name, address and registration number of the supplier;
- (ii) the name and address of the recipient;
- (iii) an individual serialized number and the date upon which the tax invoice is issued;
- (iv) a description and quantity or volume of the goods or services supplied;
- (v) the official department order number issued to the supplier;
- (vi) the value of the supply, the amount of tax charged;
- (vii) the words tax invoice in a prominent place.

# 10. PATENT RIGHTS

10.1. The supplier shall indemnify the KZN Department of Health (hear after known as the purchaser) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

#### 11. PENALTIES

11.1. if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance. The purchaser may also consider termination of the contract.

# 12. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 12.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
- (i) if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract,
- (ii) if the supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
- (iii) if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
- 12.2. In the event the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, goods, works or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs for such similar goods, works or services.
- 12.3. Where the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may decide to impose a restriction penalty on the supplier by prohibiting such supplier from doing business with the public sector for a period not exceeding 10 years.
