3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:

6. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

6.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

7.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. 1 PURPOSE, SCOPE AND DEFINITIONS OF CONTRACT WORK CATEGORIES The purpose of this contract specification is to procure the services of a reputable, competent and accredited contractor to execute maintenance and repair works on the Mechanical Equipment and related ancillaries at the KwaDukuza Medico Legal Mortuary as and when required for a period of three (3) years.

2 DEFINITIONS OF WORK CATEGORIES

The work categories are as defined under:

- Maintenance: (Preventive maintenance) defined in as work required for the upkeep of any existing equipment, which is presently in functioning and in operational order.
- Repairs:(Reactive maintenance) defined as that work required to be executed on any
 existing equipment, which is at present not functioning and must be returned to its
 original state of functioning by replacing it with new equipment of the same
 capacity/capability and technological features or by replacing components.

2.1. SCOPE OF WORK

- Conduct a once off condition assessment on the status quo of the mechanical equipment and provide a comprehensive report outlining the findings with pictures, cost and recommendations.
 - The 36th monthly report will be compared to the above report in order to determine the success of the contract.
 - The condition assessment will be expected to be conducted in the second week of the contract commencement date.
- Conduct Repairs, as and when required
- Conduct Preventative Maintenance
 - Six (6) monthly inspection on all mechanical equipment and related ancillaries and lubricate as necessary.
 - Provide report with findings, recommendations, pictures and cost.
 - Annual servicing of mechanical equipment.
- Six (6) monthly meetings at KwaDukuza Medico Legal Mortuary.
