2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
 - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- 3.4. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.

6. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

6.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

7.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. CONDITION OF CONTRACT

1. NOTES TO BIDDERS

- 1.1 The institutions will remain open and operational at all times therefore the Contractor shall make the necessary arrangements with the Institutional Management and maintenance staff for any power outages that are required. **This may necessitate weekend work**
- 1.2 All items to be priced fully inclusive of all charges e.g. labour, transport, scaffolding, materials, profit, etc., but excluding Value Added Tax.
- 1.3 The Administration reserves the right to negotiate prices in the Schedule of Prices.
- All redundant material and rubble shall to be removed from the institution's property immediately.
- 1.5 All equipment and materials used in this contract shall be that which is specified or **other** <u>approved</u> <u>prior to submission and closure of the bid.</u>
- 1.6 The Contractor is advised to examine all the drawings (if any) and to visit the site prior to tendering to acquaint him/herself with the nature of the work to be done and access to the siting of the existing buildings etc., as no claim will be allowed on the grounds of ignorance of the conditions under which the work will be executed.
- 1.7 All items in the Schedule of Prices are **PROVISIONAL** and subject to re-measure after installation.
- 1.8 The Schedule of Prices shall be read in conjunction with the Scope of Work.

 Any discrepancies or omissions shall be brought to the attention Leader of the Project immediately.
- 1.9 Preference will be given to Bidders who have registered offices / workshops within the borders of the Province of KwaZulu-Natal. This is in an effort to reduce response times to call outs for breakdowns in the more remote areas of the Province.
- 1.10 Only Contractors who are registered with a CIDB Grading of 1GB or higher shall be considered.
- 1.11 The contractor to submit three projects of the similar nature completed over the past three years with traceable references. Proof of completion certificate attached.

Failure to comply with the above requirements will result in the tender being disqualify.

1.12 **SCOPE OF CONTRACT**

The Scope of the Contract is contained in Part Three (Particular Specification).

1.14 PERIOD OF CONTRACT

Three (3) Months as the completion period for the Contract from the date of site handover.

1.15 SITE AND MODE OF PROCEDURE

The work contained in this contract will be carried out on the site of Park Rynie Forensic Mortuary in the Province of KwaZulu-Natal.

Tenderers are encouraged to visit the site to ensure successful installation of the work required.

Damage to the existing buildings - Bidders to note that any damages done or occurring to any of the buildings will be repaired at the expense of the contractor/ Bidder.

The work undertaken shall be to the satisfaction of the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Health.

1.16 **SATISFACTORY INSTALLATION**

All work shall be carried out according to the Department of Health's Standard Preambles to all Trades, the OHS Act, National Building Code of Practices and Regulations.

2. PARTICULAR SPECIFICATION

2.1 SPECIFICATIONS

2.1.1 This particular specification shall be read in conjunction with all other sections of the Specifications and cognizance shall be taken of the clauses relevant to this particular installation, whether any specific clauses are referred to or not.

2.1.2 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Tenderers must have a minimum of three projects on the work of similar nature with proven references. Tenderers to submit supporting documents information when they bidding .

Tenderers are to make special note of the following:

This particular specification must be read with, and shall form part of, Part 2 of this document (Technical Specification).

In so far as the conditions contained herein are at variance with any obtained in the Technical Specifications, the contract shall be interpreted in terms of this Particular Specification.

The whole installation shall be in accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act 85/1993 and National building ACT as amended and all regulations framed therein shall be carried out to the satisfaction of the Department of Health.

Competent workmen skilled in their trade shall carry out all work. Quality shall be of the best standard practice and all workmanship will be subject to the approval of the Department of Health.

The work shall at all times, for the duration of the contract, be carried out under supervision of a skilled and competent representative of the Service Provider, who will be able and authorized to receive and carry out instructions on behalf of the of the Service Provider. A sufficient number of workmen shall be employed at all times to ensure satisfactory progress of the work.

All apparatus, component parts, fittings and materials employed in the execution of the Contract shall be new and unused and shall be the latest type or pattern of the particular manufacture employed. S.A.B.S. mark bearing items shall be used wherever possible.

The complete installation shall be maintained as specified in this particular specification after acceptance in writing by the Department of Health.

The complete installation must be guaranteed against defective parts and workmanship for the period specified after the date of issue of the Completion Certificate. This period shall run concurrently with the maintenance period.

Rates are to include for commissioning and testing of the complete installation and handing over in working order ready for use.

Tenderers are advised to visit the site and acquaint themselves fully with the site conditions and nature and full extent of work involved prior to submitting their bid. Claims on the grounds of insufficient information in such respects or otherwise will not be entertained by the Administration.

The Department of Health reserves the right to make emergency repairs to keep the equipment in operation without voiding the Contractor's Guarantee, nor relieving the Contractor of his/her responsibility during the guarantee period when, after proper notice, the Contractor fails to attend to such emergency repairs. All costs incurred by the administration under these circumstances will be for the account of the Contractor.

3.1 **GENERAL**

This particular specification must be read with, and shall form part of, Part 1 of this document (Technical Specification).

In so far as the conditions contained herein are at variance with any obtained in the Technical Specifications, the contract shall be interpreted in terms of this Part 2 (Particular Specification).

3.2 SCOPE OF WORK

The specification calls for repairs at Park Rynie system as per the following:

Storage

• Supply and install Steel Twinspan Shelving System, 900mm x 2m x 450mm, 1000kg Load.

Admin Block

· Supply and install admin entrance door key set.

Mortuary Block

- · Supply and install reception entrance door key set.
- · Supply and install reception door arm opening mechanism.

Autopsy

Supply and install Stainless steel cabinet for autopsy.

Offloading zone

Repair or supply and install offloading roller door.

Guard House

- Supply and install new window blinder for security room.
- · Supply and install door key set handle for security room.

Note: To all replacements has to be the same with the removed part.

3.3.1 GUARANTEE AND MAINTENANCE

3.3.2.1 General

The Contractor shall guarantee and maintain the Contract Works for a period of twelve months (12) after Works Completion of the plant. During the maintenance period the Contract Works shall be maintained as specified in Clause 21 by the Contractor and any defective material, equipment or workmanship (excepting proven, willful or accidental damage, or fair wear and tear) shall be made good with all possible speed at the Contractor's expense and to the satisfaction of the client.

3.3.2.2 Making Good

When called upon by the client the Contractor shall make good on site and shall bear all expense incidental thereto including making good of work by others, arising out of removal or reinstallation of equipment. All work arising from the implementation of the guarantee or maintenance of equipment shall be carried out at times which will not result in any undue inconvenience to users of the equipment or occupants of premises.

If any defects are not remedied within a reasonable time the client may proceed to do the work at the Contractor's risk and expense, but without prejudice to any other rights which the client may have against the Contractor.

3.3.2.3. Latent Defects and Failure to Comply with Specification

The client reserves the right to demand the replacement or making good by the Contractor at his own expense of any part of the Contract which is shown to have any latent defects or not to have complied with the Specification, notwithstanding that such work has been taken over or that the guarantee period has expired.

3.3.2.4. Qualification by Tenderer

Should any specified materials or equipment in the Tenderer's opinion be of inferior quality, or be unsuitably employed, rated or loaded, the Tenderer shall prior to the submission of his tender advise the consultant accordingly. His failure to do so shall mean that he guarantees the work including all materials or equipment as specified.

3.3.2 MAINTENANCE

The entire installation including all new equipment manufactured or bought is subject to an unrestricted 12-month free maintenance and guarantee period, after the date of issue of the Completion Certificate. This also includes cover pertaining to all aspects of the equipment and associated wiring controls etc.

During the 12-month maintenance, any defects shall be made good and maintained in perfect operating condition.

4.1 Items and Pricing

4.2 Tax and Duties

Prices, tendered and paid, must include all customs, excise and import duties, and any other tariffs or taxes levied by the government or statutory body having jurisdiction on the goods provided under this contract, including Value Added Tax (applicable to the current rate).

4.3 **Rates**

Except where provision is made in the Schedule of Rates, the rates and prices inserted shall be the full rates and prices for the service delivered described under the respective items and shall cover all labor, transport, overhead charges and profit, etc. as well as the general liabilities, obligations and risks arising out of the Conditions of Contract, the overhead charges and profit being spread proportionately over the rates of the relative items in the Schedule of Rates.
