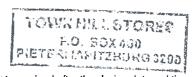
- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.

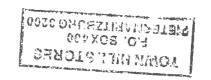

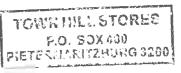

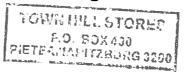
