




This system is in good condition and it runs with 407c gas, during our investigation we discovered that units tripped on low gas which then we pressure tested the systems discovered gas leaks on suctions and discharge ports, closed those valves accordingly than regased units and switch them off. Because unit and room must be pressure cleaned first before usage for hygiene purposes

The following will need to be rectified to get unit to operate:

- Re-program VSD
- Pressure clean plant room and filters (major service units)
- Note HP and LP readings
- Check loose connection as 2x circuit breakers were down
- Note air flow
- Replace V-belt
- Measure suction super heat for each system and provide reading in writing
- Note all phases for each Dx condensers and record







We have switched on the unit and is tripping the circuit breaker which we assume that this breaker is not the correct one to run this unit, it should be replaced with 32A MCB orange type special for aircons and then replace and wire control circuit. If the cable is not compatible with the replacement MCB than it must be changed, that should be assessed by King Edward Electrical team. Scope:

- Replace 24V carrel controller
- Replace 32A MCB orange type
- Rewire the control circuit
- Tension V-belt in AHU
- Note LP and HP
- Check and note start up Amps and running Amps
- · Check any loose connection
- Check unusual vibration
- Wash filters





Assessed this system discovered that the system is inacceptable condition, except the evaporator coil is on its way out, however the unit can still operate. But the institution should consider replacement in the near future. The shell and tube condenser must be roded, commission the system and note the following:

- Note the voltage
- And check for any vibration on the entire unit




Assessed the water cooled packaged units and discovered that the unit is in acceptable condition however the evaporator coil is on its way out, but unit can still work as long as the below is rectified and institution should consider replacement of this unit in the near future. This system also runs of 2x circuits and each circuit has 2x 57000 btu r22 compressors which runs in tedium, circuit 1 compressor 1 is not sounding right inside and is a sealed unit it cannot be opened. We recommend both compressors must be replaced as stated above they both run as 1 circuit.

The following parts will be required in order to get the system to operate:

- 2x 57 500 btu sanyo scrolls compressors 380v 50Hz R22 (tenduim compressors)
- 2x 5/8 liquid line driers
- · Allow 5I of 141B flushing agent
- Allow 2 ½ cylinders of R22
- Allow 6kg of nitrogen and pressure test system for leaks
- Replace contectors and overloads to suit both compressors
- · Neaten up wiring on control panel
- Replace 80mm shut off valve inside the packaged unit plant room (PVC)
- Fix the insulation of the top cover on packaged unit
- Replace V-belt A41 x 13 x105 L I (use existing for sample)
- Replace bearing on fan assembly of packaged unit and commission the system.





2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
 - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- 3.4. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.

8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

8.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

9.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

10. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

12. PATENT RIGHTS

13. PENALTIES

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2.
