If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

7.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's altocation. 1. PURPOSE, SCOPE AND DEFINITIONS OF CONTRACT WORK CATEGORIES

The purpose of this contract specification is to procure the services of a reputable, competent and accredited contractor to execute relocation of parkhome from Howick Forensic Mortuary to Greytown Forensic Mortuary.

- Relocate 1 x 12 metre x 6.8 metre parkhome from Howick Forensic Mortuary to Greytown Forensic Mortuary
- · Removal of ramp, hand rails and proportion of fence
- Disconnection of water, electricity and sewer
- · De-sitting and transport parkhome

- Erection of new ramp with a ratio of 1:15 and 1m width from the parkhome (wall) leading up to a platform
- A 3+ course of brickwork platform that joins the ramp, platform to be 1m to either side
 of the door
- Hand rails to start at the beginning of the ramp to the end of the platform and against the parkhome (wall)
- Erect 800 mm concrete apron (15 Mpa) constructed in 3m spans, 100 mm going underneath the parkhome and the remainder protruding away from the parkhome, slightly sloping for water to flow away from the parkhome
- A 3m length(to cover platform) x 1,1m width verandah joined to the roof height of the parkhome
- Reconnection of water, electricity and sewer
- Re-sitting on 450 x 450 x 50 mm concrete paving slabs with adjustable/levelling jacks
- Concrete paving slabs to be doubled at each supporting point, supporting points to be 4m apart on the longest side and 3,4m apart on the shortest side.
- Mobile crane shall be used to get the parkhome inside the yard where it is impossible for the truck to get inside the premises

1 CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1.1 NOTICE TO BIDDERS

- 1.1.1 The institutions will remain open and operational at all times therefore the Contractor shall make the necessary arrangements with the Institutional Management for isolations that may be required.
- 1.1.2 A proven experience in manufacturing, transportation and installation of parkhomes of at least 5 years, without this experience, bidders will be eliminated. Bidders to attach a company profile as well as proof of five previous projects involving the above scope as a supporting document.

- 1.1.3 All redundant material and rubble shall be removed from the institution's property immediately.
- 1.1.4 The Schedule of equipment shall be read in conjunction with the Scope of Work.
- 1.1.5 Any discrepancies or omissions shall be brought to the attention of the Project Leader immediately.
- 1.1.6 The Contractor must be registered with CIDB and must have minimum grading of 1GB or higher.
