## 3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

The Department is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote. 3.1.

- The Department reserves the right to communicate in writing with vendors in cases where information is incomplete or whe 3,2. obscurities regarding technical aspects of the offer, to obtain confirmation of prices or preference claims in cases where it is a typing, written, transfer or unit error has been made, to investigate the vendor's standing and ability to complete the su satisfactorily.

#### 13. PENALTIES

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider minstitution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution sho the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase comm similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as we commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- 13.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to c contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whethe service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- 13.4. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day until actual delivery or performance.

#### 14. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 14.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the si terminate this contract in whole or in part:
- (i) if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract,
