#### 1.3.1. PERIOD OF CONTRACT

One (01) month as the Contract Period for the completion of the Work from date of Site handover.

### 1.3.2. CONTRACT GUARANTEE:

The Bidders / Contractors / service providers will be responsible for safety catching, collection and transporting of domestic cats to an approved protection organisation design for specific animals where they cannot be mixed for example cats cannot be mixed with dogs. The service shall done according to and following animal protection act regulations as stipulated in animal act of 71 of 2019, and to the satisfaction of the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Health.

## 2. TECHINICAL SPECIFICATION

Equipment shall be of approved wire mash cages designed transport domestic cats or other as specified in the animal act 71 of 2019.

### 2.1. GENERAL

Service is excluding the service provider to conduct animal sale to Greytown Hospital staff or to public unless a written agreement is obtained from the local animal organisation. Animal has not received immunisation or similar treatment and they are not guaranteed to be transferred to second party (public) where there is no transfer paperwork.
