

The purpose of this document is to:

- Draw special attention to certain general correlitions applicable to government bids, contracts and orders; and
- To ensure that clients be families with regard to the rights and obligations of all parties involved in doing business with government.

- The General Conditions of Contract will form part of all bid protesion documents and may not be amended.
- Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) relevant to a specific bid, should be compiled separately for every bid (if applicable) and will supplement the General Conditions of Contract. Whenever there is a conflict the provisions in the SCC shall prevail.



- 1.1. "Closing lime" means the date and hour speciated in the bidding documents for the receipt of bids. 12.

 - (d) recommend that the tenderer or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the audi alteram partern (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
 - (e) forward the matter for criminal prosecution, if deemed necessary.
