## GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

NOTES

The purpose of bus document is to:

- Draw special attention to certain general conditions applicable to government bids, contracts and orders; and
- To ensure that clients be familiar with regard to the rights and obligations of all parties involved in doing business with government, (0)

In this document words in the singular also mean in the plural and vice versa and words in the masculine also mean in the feminine and neuter,

- The General Conditions of Contract will form part of all bid/quotation documents and may not be amended.
- Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) relevant to a specific bid, should be compiled separately for every bid (if applicable) and will supplement the Special Continues of Contract, to Contract, to a specific and, second be configured separately for ast General Conditions of Contract, Whenever there is a conflict, the provisions in the SCC shall prevail.

#### 1.

The following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:

- "Closing time" means the date and hour specified in the bidding documents for the receipt of bids. 1.1.
- "Contract" means the written agreement entered into between the purchaser and the supplier, as recorded in the contract form signed by the parties, 1.2 including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein. 1.3.
