- The General Conditions of Contract will form part of all bid/quotation documents and may not be arried
- Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) relevant to a specific bid, should be compiled superately for every bid (if applicable) and will supplicate the Sensial Conditions of Contract. Whenever there is a conflict, the provisions in the SCC shall prevail.

- 12 Definitions
