## **Background**

The Eskom Development Foundation approved funding to the amount of R8 240 000 towards a paediatric mobile unit, its maintenance and running cost as well as consumables for a period of 3 years. This unit will visit primary and secondary schools around Ingula power station on the Kwazulu-Natal and Free State sides. This initiative is in conjunction with both the provincial Departments of Health for KZN and Free State and will rotate on a six month basis between the two provinces.

### **➤ Objective**

The Eskom Mobile Clinic has specifically been designed to reduce the barriers that children are often faced with during their educational careers. The mobile clinic consist of a dental booth, equipped with all necessary material to screen, polish, extract and do fillings on teeth, a Primary Health Care (PHC) consultation room to carry out general health check-ups; nutritional assessments, hearing assessments, gross and fine motor assessments, as well as immunisation and a visual care booth to assess their eye sight, provide the necessary treatment and even spectacles where necessary. Learners with severe medical problems that cannot be treated within the mobile unit are referred by the medical staff to the nearest clinics and public hospitals

### **➤ Impact to date and expected impact**

To date 34 schools and 2 community location have been visited and 2300 learners have been screened since August 2014. 439 learners have been referred to the nearest clinic or hospital due to severe eye conditions, dental problems, and general health problems. 13 learners have been prescribed spectacles, all have been dispensed.

Expected impact by June 2015 is the examination of at least 1 512 children/learners screened and referred and specs provided.

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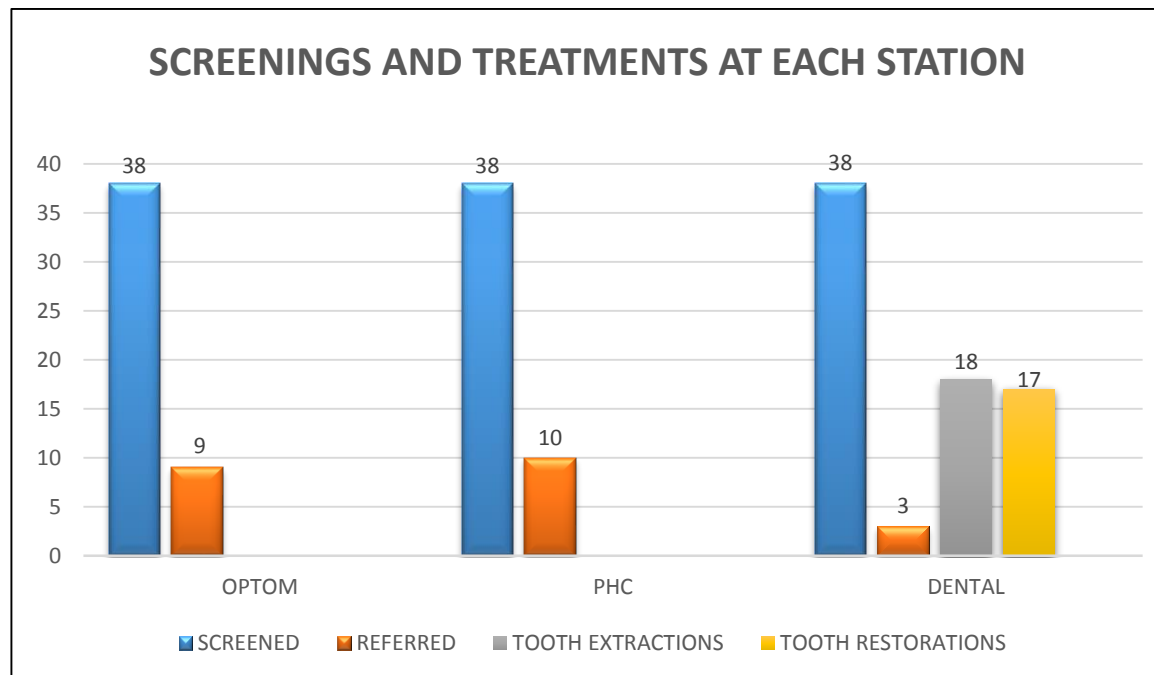


Figure 1: Number of learners screened

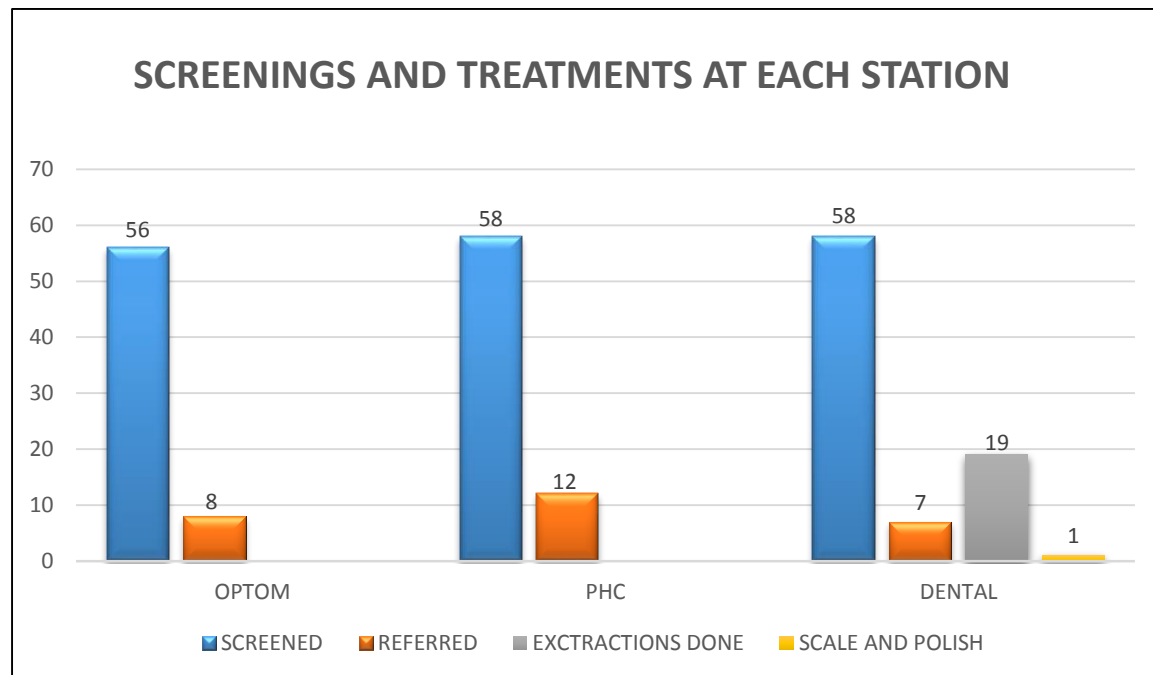


Figure 3: Number of learners screened

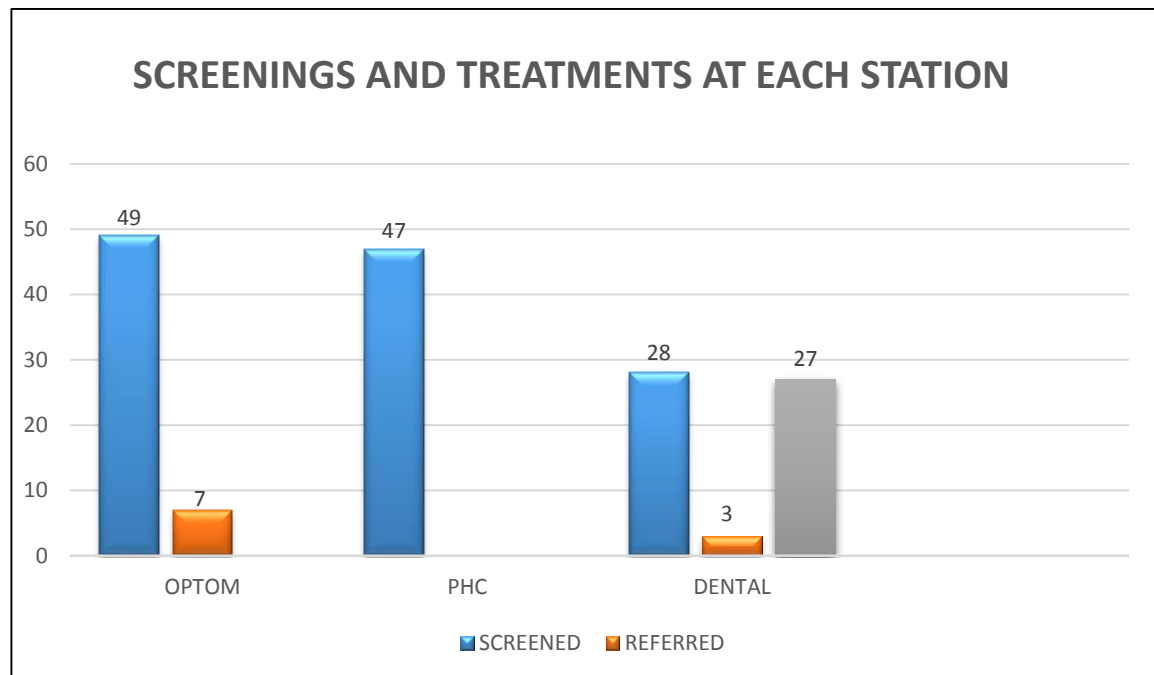


Figure 4: Number of learners screened

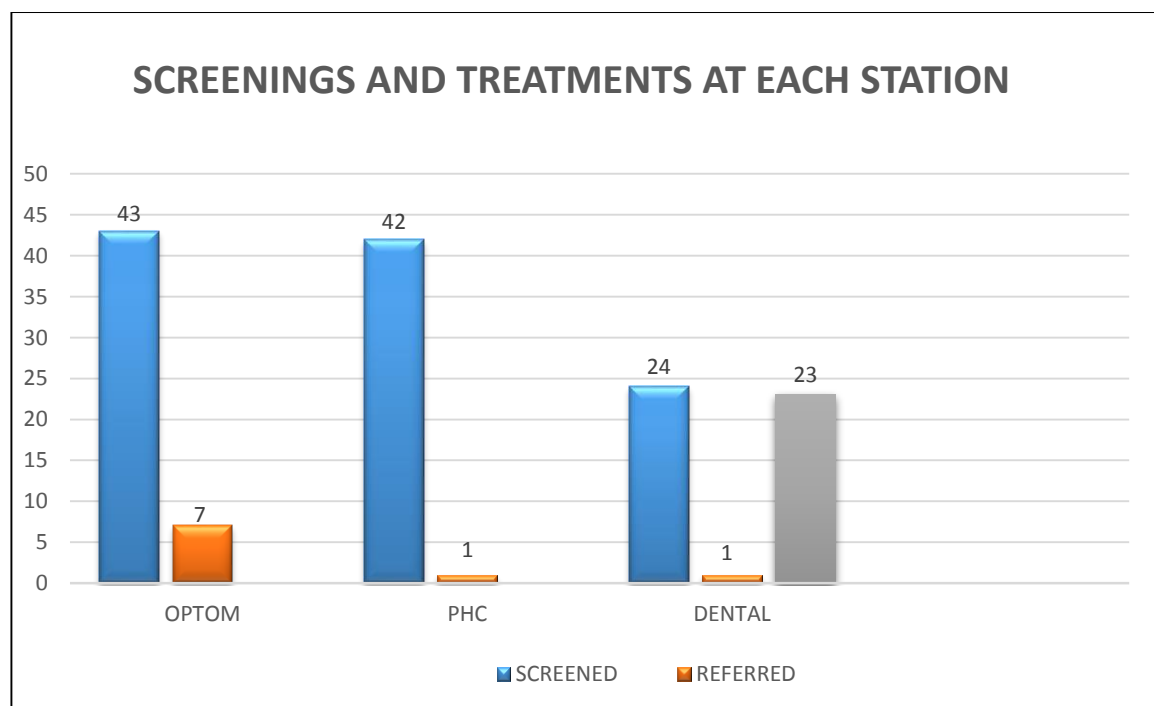

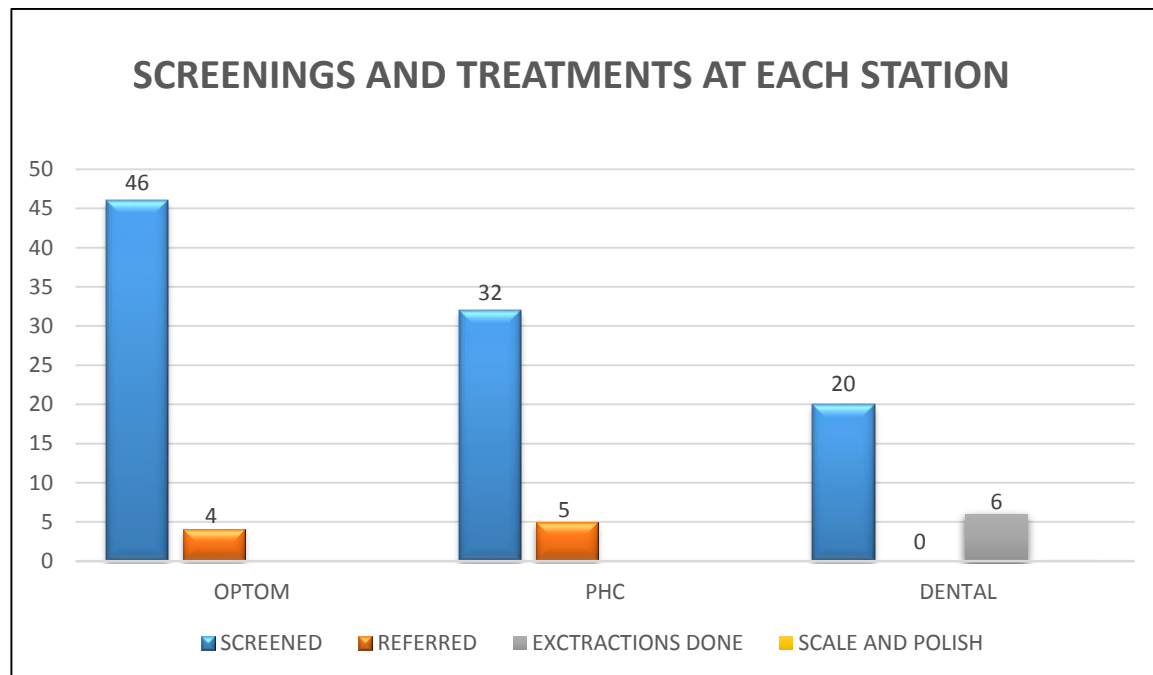


Figure 7: Number of learners screened

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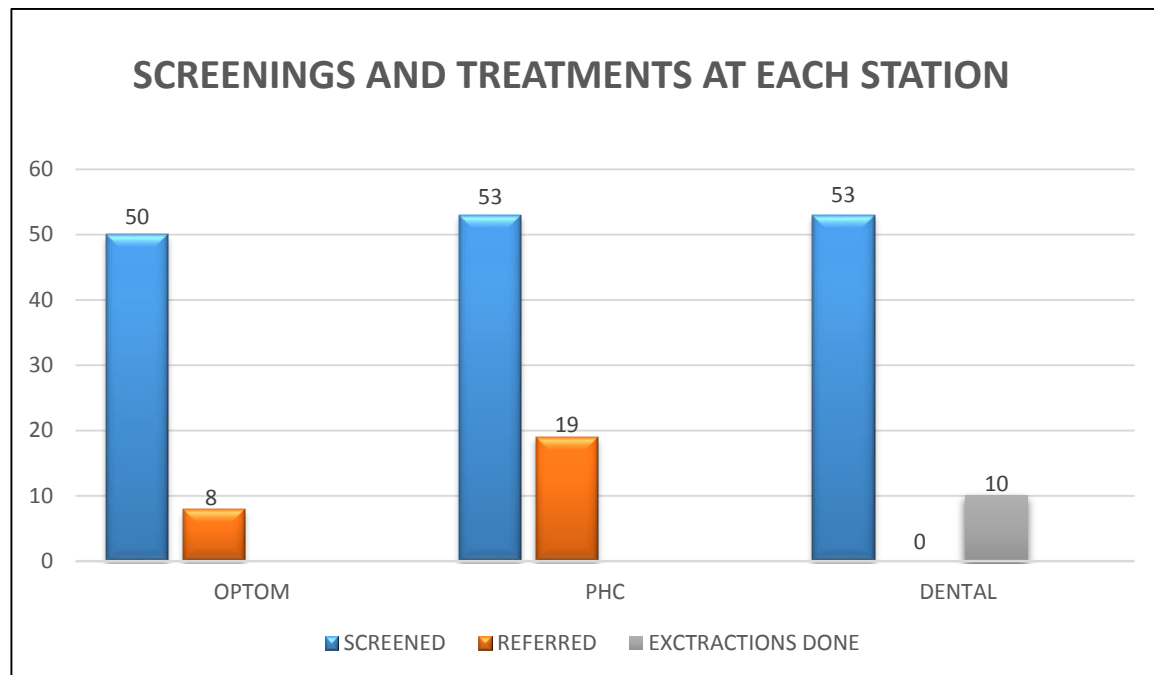


Figure 8: Number of learners screened

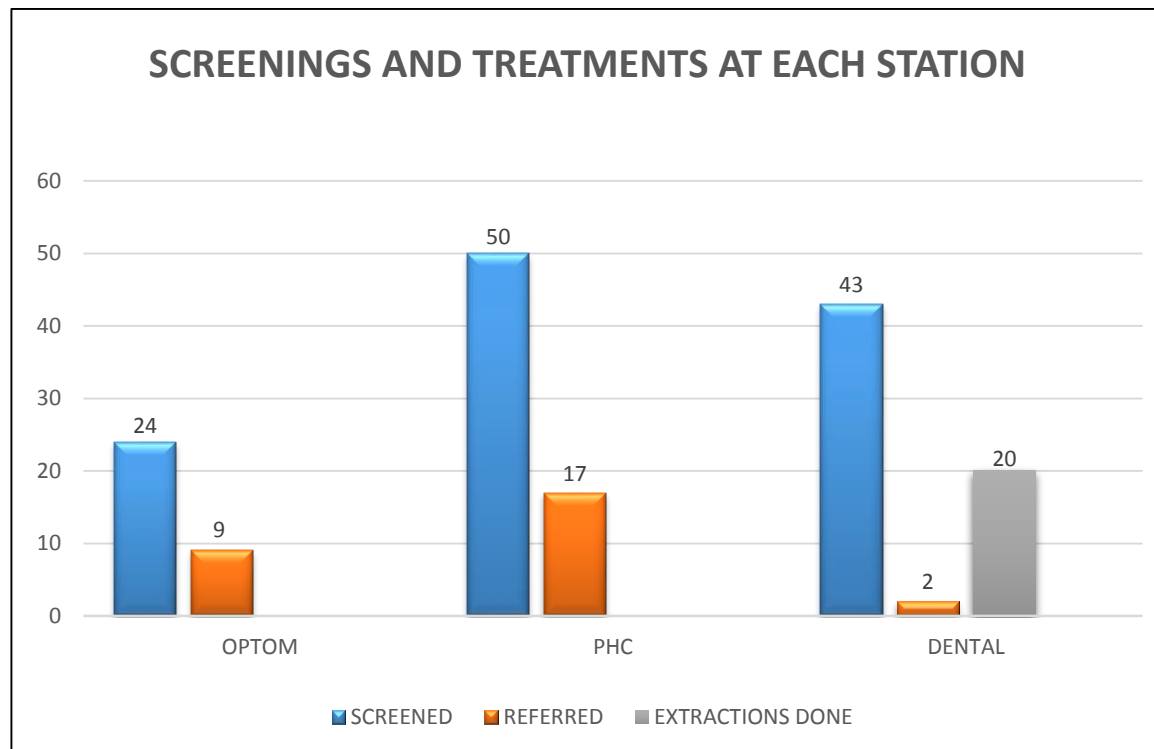


Figure 9: Number of learners screened

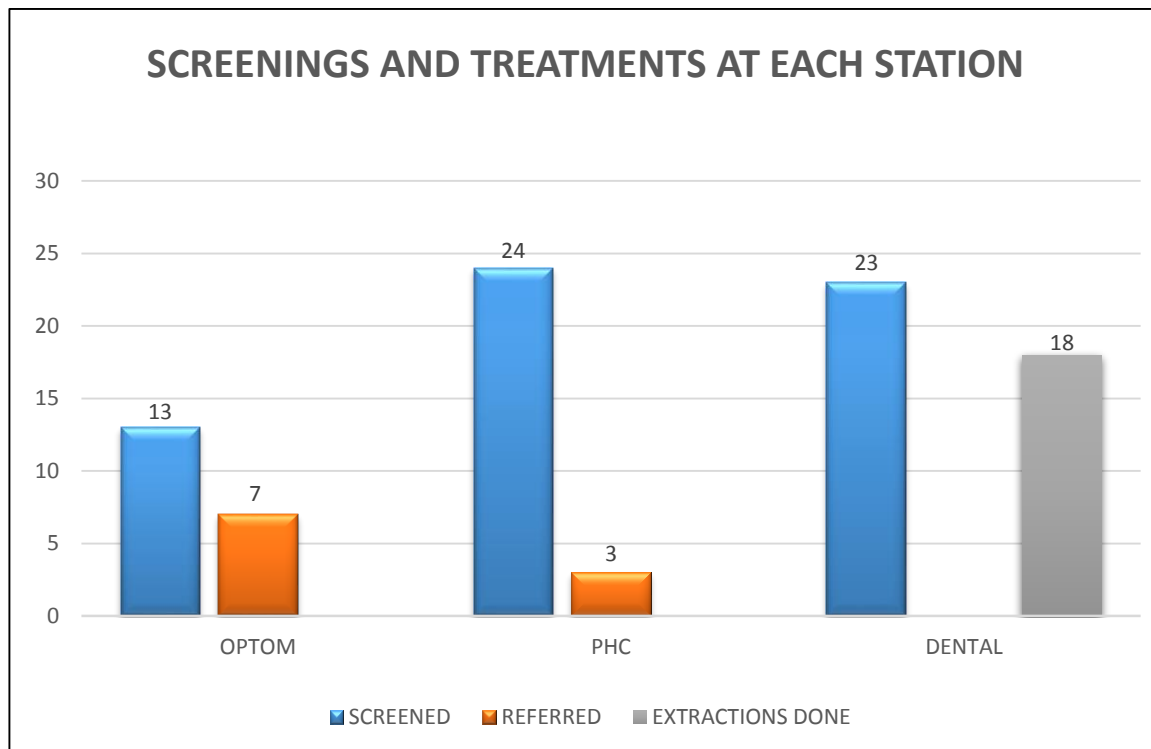


Figure 10: Number of learners screened

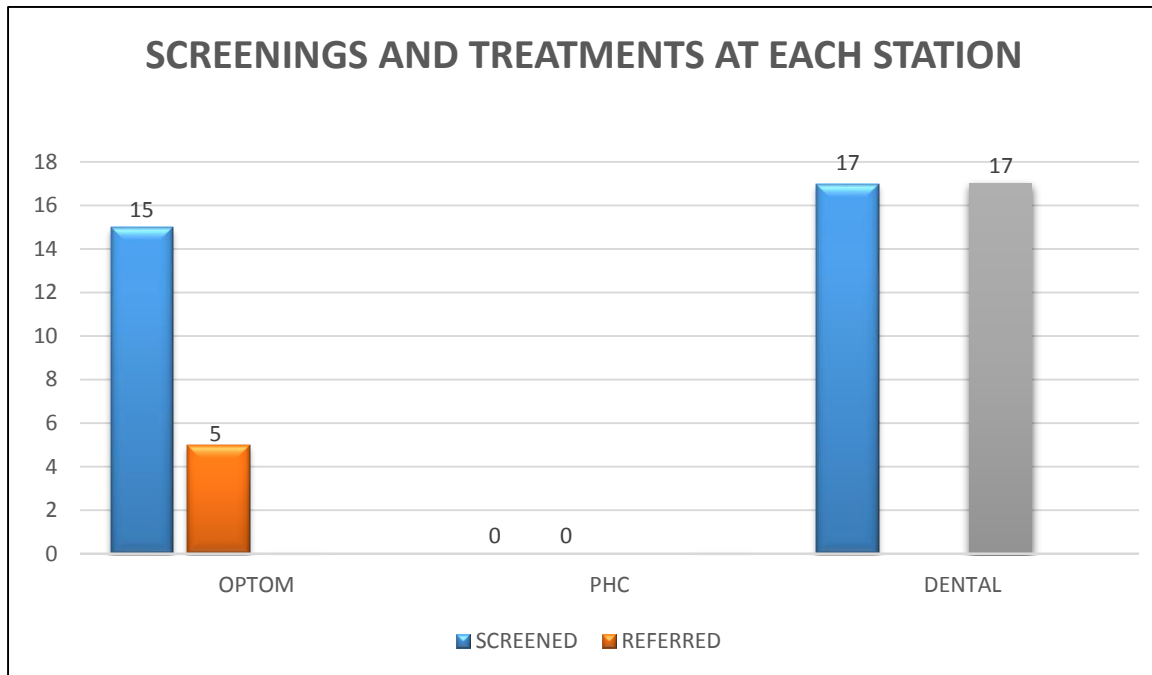


Figure 11: Number of learners screened

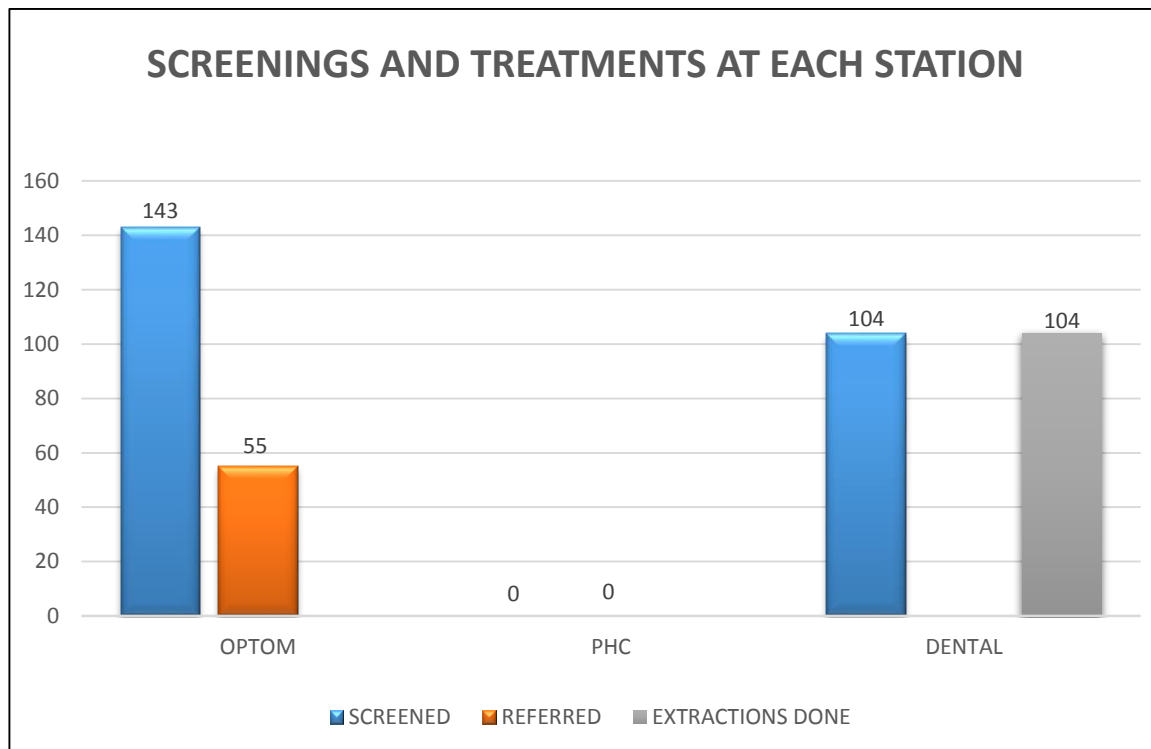


Figure 12: Number of learners screened

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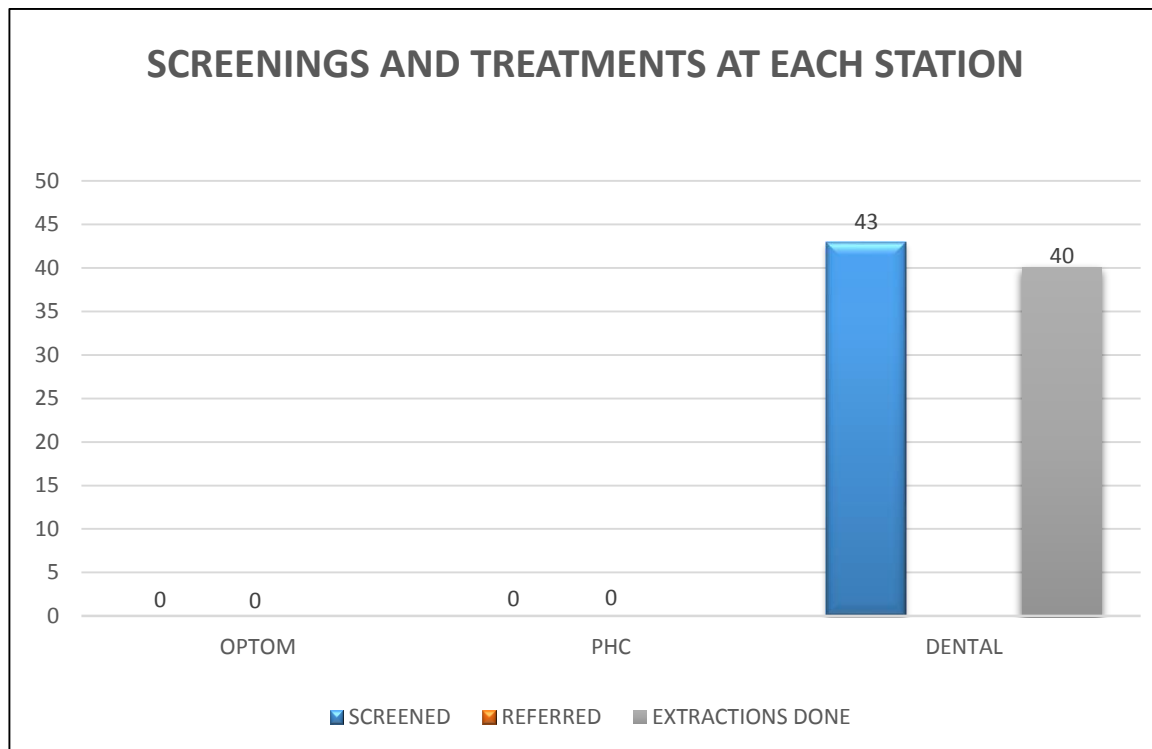


Figure 13: Number of learners screened

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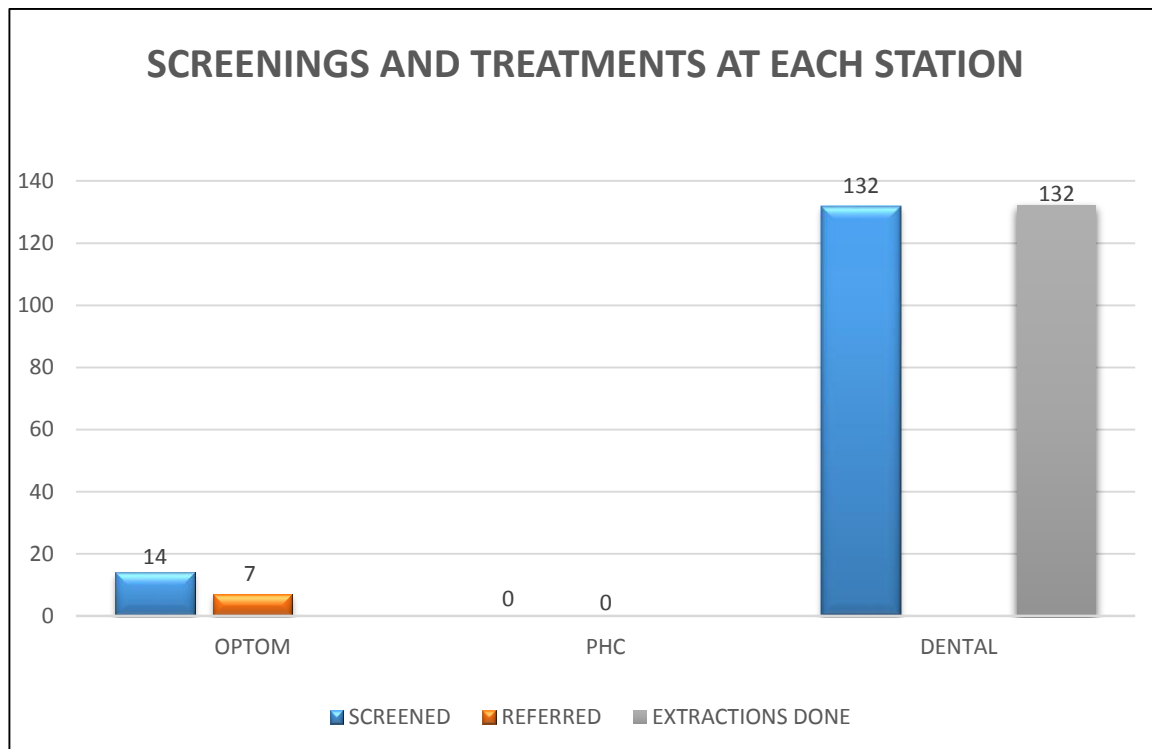


Figure 14: Number of learners screened

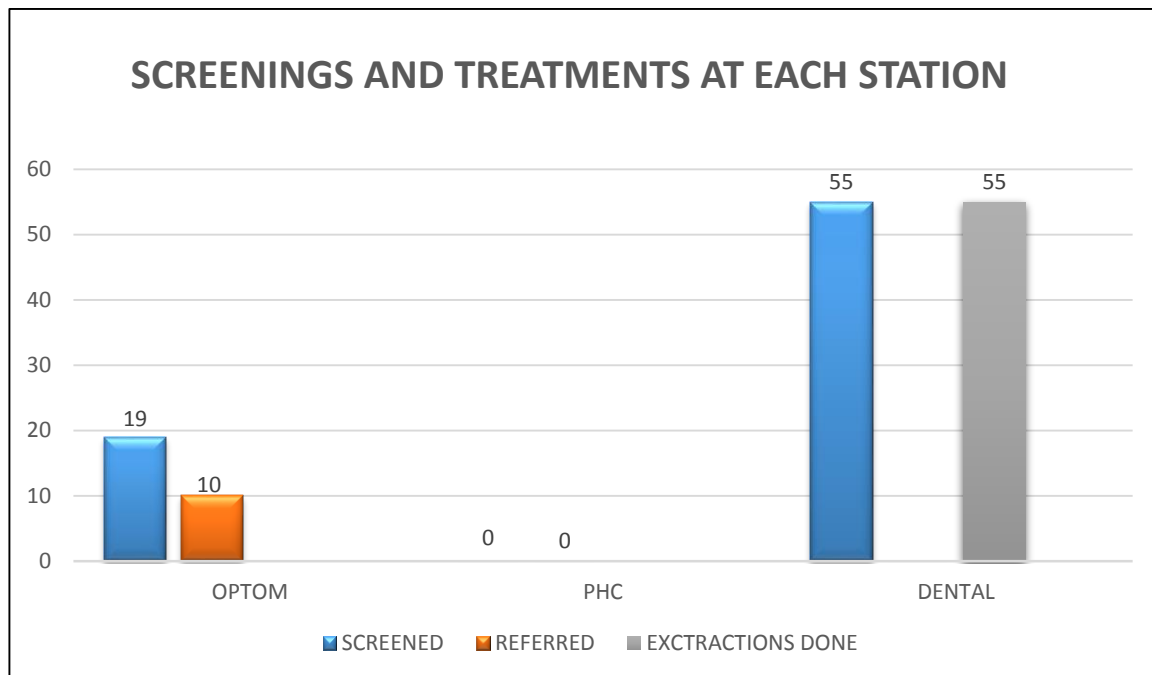


Figure 15: Number of learners screened

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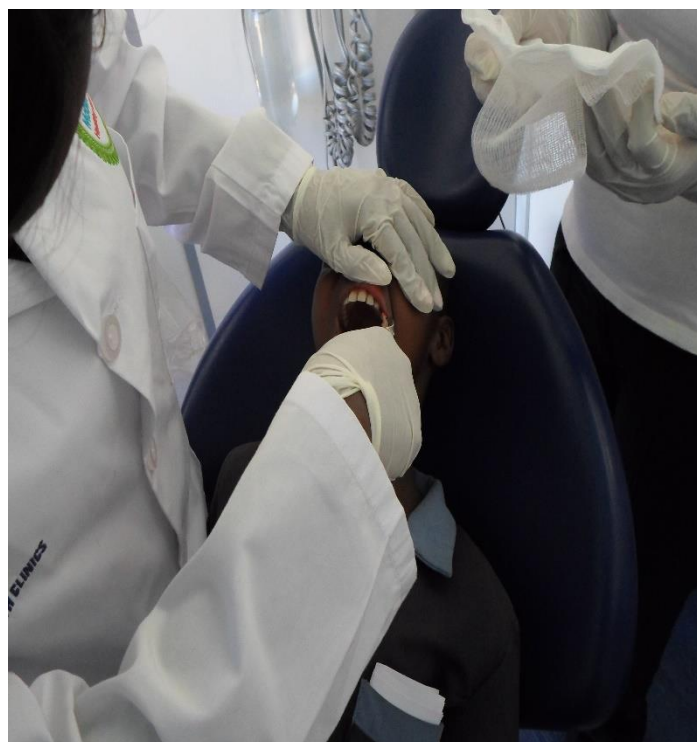
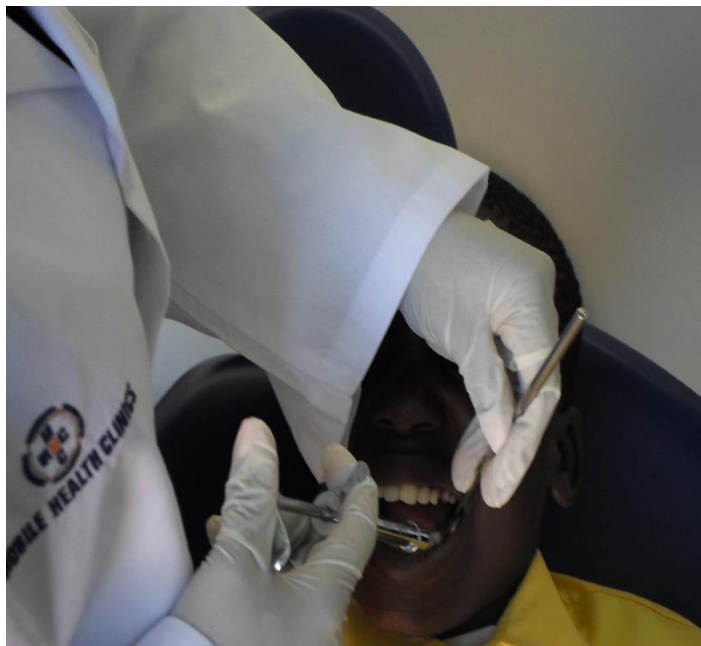
